

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Landscapes® Shaded Hat and Wristers

<u>SKILL LEVEL</u> – Easy

<u>SIZES</u>

HAT

Finished Circumference About 19 in. (48.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes WRISTERS

Finished Circumference About 8 in. (20.5 cm) **Finished Length** About 6 1/2 in. (16.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Landscapes® (Art. #545)
 - 202 Mountain Range 2 balls
- Lion Brand[®] crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



<u>GAUGE</u>

12 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm) with larger hook. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

hdc2tog (hdc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

<u>NOTES</u>

- 1. The Hat and Wristers are in an easy pattern that uses increases and decreases to create diagonal color shading.
- 2. The first section of Hat and Wristers is shaped with increases and the last section is shaped with decreases. In the center section, an increase is worked at one end and a decrease is worked at the other end of each row, so the stitch count will not change.

HAT

With larger hook, ch 3.

Increase Section

Row 1: Work 2 hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch do not count as a st) – you will have 2 hdc in this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, 2 hdc in each st – 4 hdc.

Rows 3-15: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, 2 hdc in first st, hdc in each st to last st, 2 hdc in last st – 30 hdc at the end of Row 15.

Center Section

Row 1: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last st, 2 hdc in last st.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until longest straight edge measures about 19 in. (48.5 cm).

Decrease Section

Rows 1-13: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last 2 sts, hdc2tog – 4 hdc at the end of Row 13.

Row 14: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, (hdc2tog) twice – 2 hdc.

Row 15: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, hdc2tog – 1 hdc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

Thread yarn tail into blunt and sew sides of Hat together.

Band

Note: Band is worked back and forth in rows and is joined to Hat at the end of every other row.

From RS, with smaller hook, working around one open end of Hat, join yarn with a sl st in end of first row following the Hat seam.

Set-up Rnd: Ch 1, work an even number of sc evenly spaced around edge of Hat; join with sl st in first sc.

Row 1: Ch 8, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; sl st into next sc on edge of Hat – 7 sc.

Row 2: SI st into next sc on edge of Hat, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each st across; sl st into next sc on edge of Hat.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until band has been worked all the way around edge of Hat, end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and sew ends of band together.

FINISHING

Thread blunt needle with a doubled strand of yarn. Weave needle in and out through spaces at ends of rows around end of Hat opposite band. Pull ends of strand to close top of Hat and knot. From wrong side, sew any openings at top of Hat closed.

Weave in ends.

WRISTERS (make 2)

With larger hook, ch 3.

Increase Section

Row 1: Work 2 hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch do not count as a st) – you will have 2 hdc in this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, 2 hdc in each st – 4 hdc.

Center Section

Row 1: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last st, 2 hdc in last st.

Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, 2 hdc in first st, hdc in each st to last 2 sts, hdc2tog.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until longest straight edge measures about 8 in. (20.5 cm).

Decrease Section

Rows 1-7: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last 2 sts, hdc2tog – 4 hdc at the end of Row 7.

Row 8: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, (hdc2tog) twice – 2 hdc.

Row 9: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, hdc2tog – 1 hdc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing. Sew short ends of piece together, leaving an opening for thumb.

Cuff

Note: Cuff is worked back and forth in rows and is joined to wrist edge at end of every other row.

From RS, with smaller hook, join yarn with a sl st in end of first row following seam.

Set-up Rnd: Ch 1, work an even number of sc evenly spaced around edge of Wrister; join with sl st in first sc.

Row 1: Ch 8, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; sl st into next sc on edge of Wrister – 7 sc.

Rows 2 and 3: Working around edge of Wrister, work as for Rows 2 and 3 of Hat band.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until Cuff has been worked all the way around edge of Wrister, end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing. Use yarn tail to sew ends of cuff together.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
