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<u>SKILL LEVEL</u> – Easy+

<u>SIZE</u>

Finished Circumference About 55 in. (139.5 cm) Finished Height About 7 in. (18 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Landscapes ® (Art. #545)
 - 202 Mountain Range 2 balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

10 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.



STITCH EXPLANATION

hdc2tog (hdc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

<u>NOTES</u>

- 1. Cowl is made from 12 triangles, working sts across previous triangle to begin the next and following a diagram.
- 2. Ends of piece are sewn together to make a ring, then an edging is worked around the outside edges of the Cowl.

COWL

Triangle I

Ch 24.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each sc across – 23 sc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, sk next st, hdc in next st, *ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next st; rep from * across – 12 hdc and 11 ch-1 sps.

Row 3 (Decrease Row): Ch 2 (counts as first hdc in this row and in all following rows), turn, working in back loops only, yarn over, insert hook in first ch-1 sp and draw up a loop, yarn over, insert hook in next hdc and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook, hdc in each ch-1 sp and hdc to last st before turning ch-sp, yarn over, insert hook in last st before turning ch-sp and draw up a loop, yarn over, insert hook in 2nd ch of turning ch and draw up a loop, yarn over, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 21 sts.

Row 4 (Decrease Row): Ch 2, turn, working in both loops, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in last st (top of turning ch) – 19 sts.

Row 5 (Decrease Row): Ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog; working in both loops, hdc in last st –17 sts.

Rows 6-13: Rep Rows 2-5 twice – 5 sts at the end of Row 13.

Row 14: Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, sk next st, hdc in next st, ch 1, sk next st, hdc in last st – 3 hdc and 2 ch-1 sps.

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Row 15: Ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, yarn over, insert hook in first ch-1 sp and draw up a loop, yarn over, insert hook in next hdc and draw up a loop, yarn over, insert hook in next ch-1 sp and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through all 7 loops on hook; working in both loops, hdc in last st – 3 sts. **Row 16:** Ch 1, turn, sk first 2 sts, sc in top of turning ch – 1 st. Do not fasten off.

Triangle II

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, turn, work 23 sc evenly spaced across side edge of Triangle I – 23 sc.

Rows 2-16: Work same as Rows 2-16 of Triangle I. Do not fasten off.

Triangle III

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, turn, work 23 sc evenly spaced across side edge of Triangle II – 23 sc.

Rows 2-16: Work same as Rows 2-16 of Triangle I. Fasten off.

Triangle IV

Row 1 (RS): From RS, and following diagram, join yarn with a sl st in corner of previous Triangle to work across side edge, ch 1, work 23 sc evenly spaced across side edge – 23 sc.

Rows 2-16: Work same as Rows 2-16 of Triangle I. Do NOT fasten off.

Triangle V

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, turn, work 23 sc evenly spaced across side edge of previous Triangle – 23 sc.

Rows 2-16: Work same as Rows 2-16 of Triangle I. Fasten off.

Triangles VI-XI

Rep Triangles IV and V three more times.

Triangle XII

Rep Triangle IV. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew ends of piece together to make a ring.

Edging

From RS, join yarn with a sl st at either end of seam. Ch 1, working evenly along outside edge of piece, work (sc, ch 1) around; join with sl st in first sc.

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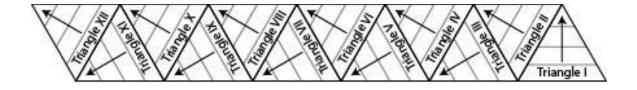
Repeat edging around opposite edge of Cowl.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made hdc = half double crochet rep = repeat RS = right side sc = single crochet sk = skip sl st = slip stitch st(s) = stitch(es)
