

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Shawl in a Ball Traver's Island Poncho

SKILL LEVEL – Easy+

<u>SIZES</u>

S-L (1X-3X)

Finished Width About 27 (33) in. (68.5 (84) cm), including side edging **Finished Length** About 20 (22) in. (51 (56) cm), after folding and seaming **Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Shawl in a Ball (Art. #828)
 205 Soothing Blue 2 (3) balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook F-5 (3.75 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle





2 pattern reps + 8 1/2 rows = about 3 3/4 in. (9.5 cm) over Rows 2-7 of pattern. **Note:** In Rows 2, 3 and 7 of pattern, one pattern rep consists of a CI and the following 5 dc. In Row 4, one pattern rep consists of a ch-3 sp and the following 5 dc. In Rows 5 and 6, one pattern rep consists of 8 dc. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

CI (cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), yarn over, insert hook in *same* st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

NOTES

- 1. Poncho is made from 2 identical pieces: Front and Back.
- 2. Front and Back are both worked from side to side with shaping for neck.
- 3. Sides are joined at underarms and an edging is worked around the neck.

BACK

Ch 87 (95).

First Side

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc) and in next 3 ch, *ch 3, Cl in top of last dc made, sk next 3 ch, dc in next 5 ch; rep from * across – you will have 10 (11) pattern reps with an additional 5 dc at beg of this row (consisting of 10 (11) clusters, and 11 (12) 5-dc groups).

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next 4 dc, *ch 3, Cl in top of last dc made, sk next Cl, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * across working last dc in top of beg ch.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next 4 dc, *ch 3, sk next Cl, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next 4 dc, *3 dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * across working last dc in top of beg ch-3 – 85 (93) dc.

Row 6: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in each dc across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Row 7: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next 4 dc, *ch 3, Cl in top of last dc made, sk next 3 dc, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * across working last dc in top of beg ch-3. **Rows 8-19 (25):** Rep Rows 2-7 for 2 (3) more times.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (WS): Turn, sl st in first 5 sts, ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), Cl in 3rd ch of beg ch-6, sk first Cl, dc in next 5 dc, *ch 3, Cl in top of last dc made, sk next Cl, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * across working last dc in top of beg ch-3 – 10 (11) pattern reps and 1 dc at beg this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next 4 dc, *ch 3, Cl in top of last dc made, sk next Cl, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * to last Cl, ch 3, Cl in top of last dc made, sk last Cl, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-6.

Row 3: Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), turn, sk first Cl, dc in next 5 dc, *ch 3, sk next Cl, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next 4 dc, *3 dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * to last beg ch-sp, 3 dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-6 - 81 (89) dc.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in each dc across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Row 6: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next 4 dc, *ch 3, Cl in top of last dc made, sk next 3 dc, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * to last 4 dc, ch 3, Cl in top of last dc made, sk next 3 dc, dc in top of beg ch-3.

Row 7: Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), turn, Cl in 3rd ch of beg ch-6, sk first Cl, *dc in next 5 dc, ch 3, Cl in top of last dc made, sk next Cl; rep from * to beg-ch 3, dc in top of beg ch-3 – 10 ch-3 sps, ten 5-dc groups, and 1 dc at beg of this row.

Rows 8-13: Rep Rows 2-7 of Shape Neck.

Rows 14-18: Rep Rows 2-6 of Shape Neck.

Second Side

Row 1 (WS): Ch 6 (counts as 3 base ch and first dc), turn, dc in 4th ch from hook and in next 2 ch, dc in next dc, *ch 3, Cl in top of last dc made, sk next Cl, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * across, working last dc in top of beg ch-3 – 10 (11) pattern reps with an additional 5 dc at beg of this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next 4 dc, *ch 3, Cl in top of last dc made, sk next Cl, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * across working last dc in top of beg ch.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next 4 dc, *ch 3, sk next Cl, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next 4 dc, *3 dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * across working last dc in top of beg ch-3 – 85 (93) dc.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in each dc across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Row 6: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next 4 dc, *ch 3, Cl in top of last dc made, sk next 3 dc, dc in next 5 dc; rep from * across working last dc in top of beg ch-3. **Row 7:** Rep Row 2.

Rows 8-19 (25): Rep Rows 2-7 of Second Side for 2 (3) times.

Row 20(26): Rep Row 3.

Last 2 Rows (Side Edging Row): Rep Rows 4 and 5 of Second Side. Fasten off.

Side Edging

Row 1 (RS): From RS, working along opposite side of foundation ch, join yarn with sl st in ch at base of first st, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each ch across. **Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each st across. Fasten off.

FRONT

Make same as Back.

FINISHING

Sew shoulders.

Sew side edges together for about 1/2 in. (1.5 cm), about 10 (11) in. (25.5 (28) cm) below shoulder seam for armholes.

Neck Edging

From RS, join yarn with sc at neck edge of one shoulder seam. Work sc evenly spaced all the way around neck edge; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.


Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning) ch = chain ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made dc = double crochet rem = remain(ing) rep(s) = repeat(s) RS = right side sc = single crochet sk = skip sl st = slip stitch st(s) = stitch(es) tog = together WS = wrong side
