

# Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Cupcake® Easy Triangle Shawl Pattern Number: L70268



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE About 17 x 73 in. (43 x 185.5 cm), at widest and longest

# **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Cupcake® (Art. #935)
  - 214 Moody Blue 1 ball
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 5 (3.75 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

## <u>GAUGE</u>

18 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every st on every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

# STITCH EXPLANATIONS

**kfb (knit in front and back)** Knit next st without removing it from left hand needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

## yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.

2. Take yarn to back, over the right hand needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

## <u>NOTES</u>

- 1. Shawl is worked in one piece in Garter st (knit every st on every row) and shaped to make an asymmetric triangle.
- 2. The first st of every row is slipped for a neat edge. Slip the st as if to knit or as if to purl, whichever you prefer.
- 3. Increases are worked at the beginning of RS rows and end of WS rows and decreases are worked at the end of RS rows to shape the Shawl.
- 4. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth on the circular needle as if you were working on straight needles.
- 5. For those who find a visual helpful, we have included a chart.

# SHAWL

Cast on 4 sts.

Row 1 (RS): SI 1, kfb, k1, p1 – you will have 5 sts in this row.

Row 2: SI 1, k2tog, kfb, p1 – 5 sts.

Row 3: SI 1, kfb, k2tog, p1.

**Row 4:** SI 1, k to last 2 sts, kfb, p1 - 6 sts.

Row 5: Sl 1, kfb, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, p1.

**Row 6:** SI 1, k to last 2 sts, kfb, p1 – 7 sts.

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Rows 7-132: Rep Rows 5 and 6 until you have a total of 70 sts.

#### Begin Lace Section

Row 1 (RS): SI 1, kfb, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, p1. Row 2: SI 1, \*yo, k2tog; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k1, kfb, p1 – 71 sts. Row 3: SI 1, kfb, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, p1. Row 4: SI 1, \*yo, k2tog; rep from \* to last 2 sts, kfb, p1 – 72 sts. Rows 5-20: Rep Rows 1-4 for 4 more times – 80 sts at the end of Row 20. Row 21: SI 1, kfb, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, p1. Row 22: SI 1, kto last 2 sts, kfb, p1 – 81 sts. Rows 23-40: Rep Rows 21 and 22 for 9 times – 90 sts at the end of Row 40. Rows 41-160: Rep Rows 1-40 for 3 times more – 150 sts. Rows 161-190: Rep Rows 1-30 – 165 sts.

Bind off.


#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

k = knit k2tog = knit 2 stitches together p = purl rep = repeat RS = right side sl = slip st(s) = stitch(es) WS = wrong side
