# <u>SIZE</u>

About 30 x 37 in. (76 x 94 cm)

#### MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Cupcake® (Art. #935)
  - 211 Beach Ball 1 ball (A)
  - 212 Sunny Day 1 ball (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size G-6 (4 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

# <u>GAUGE</u>

1 ripple = about 3 in. (7.5 cm) measured from peak to peak. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

# NOTES

- 1. The Afghan is worked in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
- 2. Two colors of yarn are used, one at a time, to make the Afghan.
- 3. The ripple in this design is created by skipping 2 sts to form valleys and working 3 dc all in the same st to form peaks. In each row, take care to skip the 2 sts in each valley and work 3 dc at each peak.
- 4. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

# AFGHAN

With A, ch 130.

**Row 1:** Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc), dc in next 3 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 5 ch, \*sk next 2 ch, dc in next 5 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 5 ch; rep from \* across – you will have 10 ripples in this row.

**Row 2:** Turn, sk first dc, sl st in next dc, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 4 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc, \*sk next 2 dc, dc in next 5 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc; rep from \* across; leave beg ch-3 unworked.

Rep Row 2 until there is not enough yarn A remaining to complete another row.

Fasten off.

**Next Row:** Turn, sk first dc, join B with a sl st in next dc, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 4 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc, \*sk next 2 dc, dc in next 5 dc, 3 dc in next 6, dc in next 5 dc; rep from \* across; leave beg ch-3 unworked.

With B, rep Row 2 until there is not enough yarn B remaining to complete another row.

Fasten off.
