



Free Knitting Pattern
Lion Brand® Heartland®
Amelia Cowl
Pattern Number: L70360



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

About 10 x 32 in. (25.5 x 81.5 cm), before seaming

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
 - 133 Arches 2 balls
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 7 (4.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® cable needle
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

20 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1-10.
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

4/4 LC (4 over 4 left cross) Slip 4 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work, k4, then k4 from cable needle.

NOTES

1. Cowl is worked in one piece in Garter st (knit every st on every row) and an easy cable.
2. Finished piece is seamed, following a diagram, to make the Cowl.

COWL

Cast on 50 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K7, place marker (pm), p8, pm, k to end of row.

Row 2: K across, slipping markers as you come to them.

Row 3: K to marker, slip marker (sm), p8, sm, k to end of row.

Row 4: K to marker, sm, work 4/4 LC over the 8 sts between markers, sm, k to end of row.

Row 5: Rep Row 3.

Rows 6-9: Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Row 10: Rep Row 4.

Row 11: Rep Row 3.

Rows 12-19: Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Row 20: Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-20 until piece measures about 32 in. (81.5 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 7 or 13 as the last row you work.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Following diagram, seam piece to make the Cowl.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

WS = wrong side
