## **SKILL LEVEL – Easy**

### **SIZE**

About 32 x 32 in. (81.5 x 81.5 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Feels Like Butta (Art. #215)
  - 158 Lemon 2 balls (A)
  - 146 Lilac 2 balls (B)
  - 156 Mint 2 balls (C)
  - 101 Pink 2 balls (D)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 7 (4.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

17 sts + 34 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every st on every row).

1 Strip = about 8 in. (20.5 cm) wide.

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

### **NOTES**

1. Four Strips are worked separately, then sewn together to make the Blankie.
2. Each Strip is worked with 4 colors of yarn to create a patchwork block effect.

### **STRIP I**

With A, cast on 34 sts.

With A, work in Garter st (knit every st on every row) until piece measures about 8 in. (20.5 cm) from beginning.

Change to B.

With B, knit. Mark this row as the right side of the Blankie.

Continue in Garter st with B until B block of color measures about 8 in. (20.5 cm), be sure to end with a wrong side row as the last row you work.

Change to C, and continue in Garter st until C block of color measures about 8 in. (20.5 cm), again ending with a wrong side row as the last row you work.

Change to D and continue in Garter st until D block of color measures about 8 in. (20.5 cm).

Bind off.

### **STRIP II**

Make same as Strip I, using colors in this order: B, C, D and A.

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### **STRIP III**

Make same as Strip I, using colors in this order: C, D, A and B.

### **STRIP IV**

Make same as Strip I, using colors in this order: D, A, B and C.

### **FINISHING**

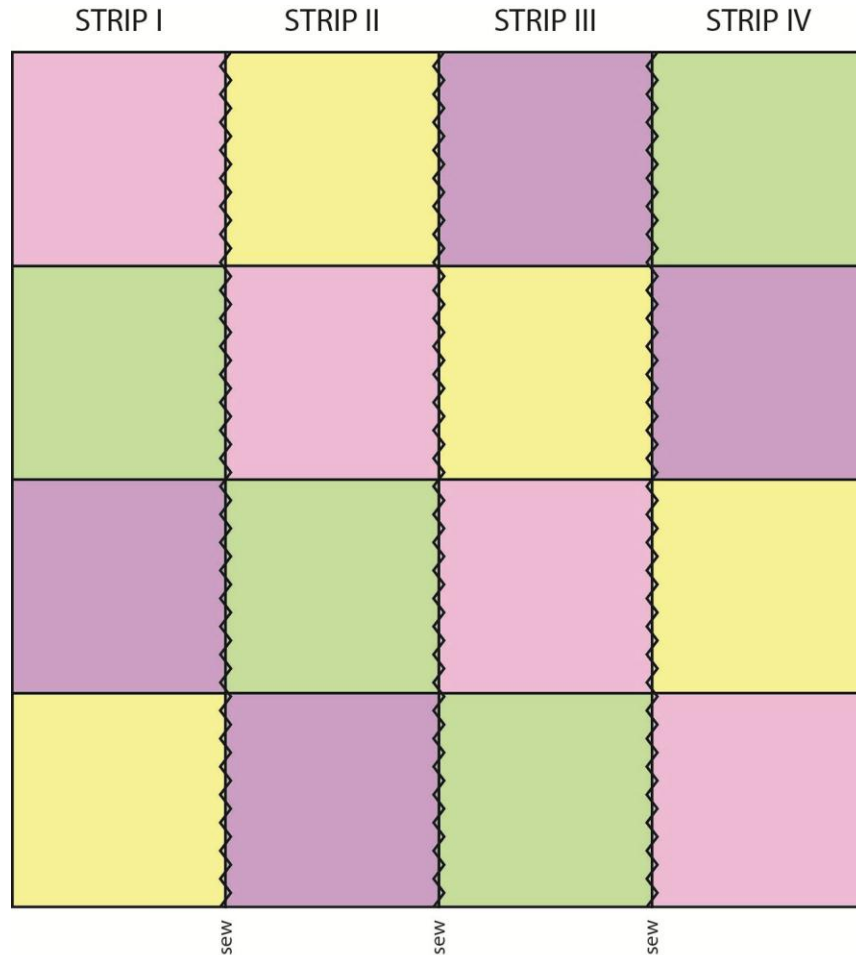
Following the diagram, sew long edges of Strips together.





Weave in ends.
