

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Ice Cream® Big Scoop® Garter Squares Baby Throw Pattern Number: L70270

SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

About 28 x 28 in. (71 x 71 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Ice Cream® Big Scoop® (Art. #922)
 - 215 Moon Mist 1 ball
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 5 (3.75 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eved blunt needle



GAUGE

20 sts + 40 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every stitch on every row).

1 Square = about 14 x 14 in. $(35.5 \times 35.5 \text{ cm})$.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. The Throw is worked all in Garter stitch (knit every st on every row).
- 2. Stitches for Squares II, III and IV are picked up along the edge of previous Squares. Only one seam will need to be sewn!
- 3. For those who find a visual helpful, we have provided a construction diagram.

THROW

Square I

Cast on 70 sts.

Work in Garter st (k every st on every row) for 139 rows.

Bind off, leaving the last bound-off st on the needle.

Square II

Beg with 1 st on right needle, pick up and k69 sts along side edge of Square I – 70 sts.

Work in Garter st for 139 rows.

Bind off, leaving the last bound-off st on the needle.

Square III

Beg with 1 st on right needle, pick up and k69 sts along side edge of Square II – 70 sts.

Work in Garter st for 139 rows.

Bind off, leaving the last bound-off st on the needle.

Square IV

Beg with 1 st on right needle, pick up and k69 sts along side edge of Square III – 70 sts.

Work in Garter st for 139 rows.

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Bind off all sts, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Thread yarn tail of Square IV into blunt needle and sew side edge of Square IV to cast-on edge of Square I.

Weave in ends.
