<u>SKILL LEVEL</u> – Easy

<u>SIZES</u>

1 year (2-3 years, 4 years) Finished Chest About 22 (24, 26) in. (56 (61, 66) cm) Finished Length About 11 (12, 14) in. (28 (30.5, 35.5) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Flikka (Art. #431)
 - 709 Wading Pool 3 (3, 4) balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

2 buttons, about 1/2 in. (13 mm) diameter Sewing needle and thread

<u>GAUGE</u>

15 dc + 8 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. Cardi is worked in one piece beginning at lower edge.
- 2. At armholes, piece is divided and fronts and back are worked separately.
- 3. Sleeves and Hood are crocheted separately and sewn to Cardi.

CARDI

Ch 83 (91, 98).

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 82 (90, 97) sts.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across.

Rows 3-11 (11, 13): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Divide for Fronts and Back

Left Front

Row 1 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 20 (22, 24) dc; leave rem sts unworked for back and right front – 21 (23, 25) dc.

Rows 2-8 (10, 12): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.



Shape Neck

Row 1 (WS): Turn, sl st in first 11 (12, 13) sts, ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next dc, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3 – 10 (11, 12) dc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Fasten off.

Back

From WS, join yarn with a sl st in first unworked st of Body following left front.

Row 1 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 39 (43, 46) dc; leave rem sts unworked for right front -40 (44, 47) dc.

Rows 2-10 (12, 14): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Fasten off.

Right Front

From WS, join yarn with a sl st in first unworked st of Body following back.

Row 1 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each dc across working last dc in top of beg ch-3 – 21 (23, 25) dc.

Rows 2-8 (10, 12): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 9 (10, 11) dc; leave rem sts unworked for right front neck – 10 (11, 12) dc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Fasten off.

SLEEVES (make 2)

Ch 22 (25, 28).

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 21 (24, 27) sts.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across.

Rows 3-10 (12, 14) (Increase Rows): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first st (increase made), dc in each st to 1 dc before beg ch, 2 dc in last dc, dc in top of beg ch-3 - 37 (44, 51) sts.

Next 4 (3, 2) Rows: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across. Fasten off.

HOOD

Ch 62 (66, 70).

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 61 (65, 69).

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across, working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Rep Row 3 until piece measures about 6 1/2 (7, 8) in. (16.5 (18, 20.5) cm) from beginning. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew Sleeve seams then sew Sleeves into armholes. Following diagram, fold Hood in half, then sew edges together for back seam. Sew Hood to neck edge of Cardi.

Edging

From RS, join yarn with a sl st in lower right front corner of Cardi.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, work sc evenly spaced along right front edge, hood edge and left front edge to lower left front corner.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sl st in each st along left front and hood edges; sl st in first 2 sts at beg of right front edge, ch 2, sk next 2 sts for buttonhole, sl st in next 4 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts for buttonhole, sl st in each remaining st to end of row -2 buttonholes made.

Fasten off.

With sewing needle and thread, sew buttons to left front, opposite buttonholes. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS
