SKILL LEVEL – Beginner

SIZE

About 30 x 30 in. (76 x 76 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Cute as a Button (Art. #214)
 - 203 Alice 4 balls
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 10.5 (6.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

GAUGE

10 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Garter stitch (knit every st on every row).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Afghan is worked in one piece, diagonally from corner to corner in Garter st (knit every st on every row).
2. In the first half of the Afghan, you'll increase 1 st on every row, on the second half of the Afghan, you'll decrease 1 st on every row.
3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle, just as if working on straight needles.

AFGHAN

Cast on 3 sts.

Knit one row.

Increase Half

First Increase Row: Knit 1, knit into front and then back of the next st (thus increasing one st), knit the last st - you'll have 4 sts.

Next Increase Row: Knit 1, knit into front and then back of the next st, knit to the end of the row.

Repeat the last Increase Row until you have 108 sts on your needle.

Decrease Half

Decrease Row: Knit 1, knit the next 2 sts together (thus decreasing one st), then knit to the end of the row.

Repeat the Decrease Row until you have 3 sts remaining on your needle.

Knit one row.

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Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends.
