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SIZE

Small Star about 7 in. (18 cm)
Large Star about 9 in. (23 cm)
Moon about 9 1/2 in. (24 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® - LONDON KAYE® THEME PACK (Art. #3001)
#621 Starry Night Pack
- LION BRAND® - LONDON KAYE® HOOK WITH A TWIST™ (Art. #3002)
#302 Medium (11.5 mm) crochet hook
#303 Large (20 mm) crochet hook

YOU'LL ALSO NEED

Hot glue and glue gun

Wrap it! Glue it! Tie it!

London's designs reflect a free-spirited, improvisational approach to yarn crafting.

London uses a slip knot and just 3 stitches in her designs – a chain stitch, a slip stitch and a single crochet stitch. Watch our how-to videos at LionBrand.com/londonkaye for how to make a slip knot and how to do each of the 3 stitches.

Remember that London's style is big loose stitches! Don't pull your yarn tightly or try for uniform, even stitches. Our diagrams show orderly stitches. Use the diagrams to plot your course, but we encourage you to go your own way and place your stitches as you like.

Our patterns are meant to inspire you to embrace your creative spirit!

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Yarn colors in the **Starry Night Theme Pack-**

- #106 Baby Blues 1 ball (A)
- #105 Ice Cubes 1 ball (B)
- #110 True Blue 1 ball (C)
- #114 Round Midnight 1 ball (D)
- #159 Shooting Star 1 ball (E)

KEY

- chain
- × single crochet
- slip stitch

HERE'S HOW

Small Star

Make as many or as few small stars as you'd like using yarn colors A-D.



Step 1 Make a slip knot onto the medium hook and chain 3. Join the last chain to the first chain with a slip stitch to make a ring.



Step 2 Chain 1, make 10 sc in the ring, then slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 10 sc.

Terms

sc = single crochet

turn = turn your piece around so that the side that was facing you is now facing away from you.



Step 3 Chain 1, *make 2 sc in the next sc, make 1 sc in the next sc; repeat from * 4 more times, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 15 sc.

Points

Five points are worked back and forth in rows around the edge of Step 3.



Step 4 Chain 1, make 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc – you'll have 3 sc.



Step 6 Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in the last sc – you'll have 1 sc.

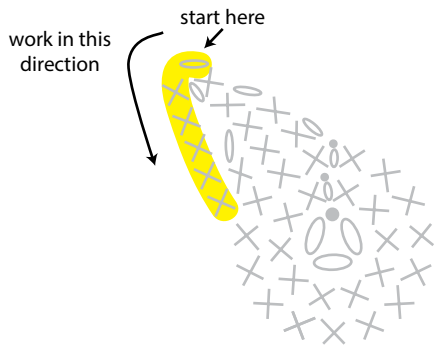


Step 5 Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in each of the last 2 sc – you'll have 2 sc.



Step 7 Chain 1, turn, sc in the sc.

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Step 8 Chain 1, turn, make sc stitches evenly spaced along the side edge of the point.



Step 9 Make 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc of Step 3.



Step 10 Repeat Steps 5-9 to make a total of 4 points, then repeat Steps 5-8 to complete the 5th point.

Fasten off.

Large Star

Make as many or as few large stars as desired using yarn colors A-D.



Step 1 Make a slip knot onto the medium hook and chain 3. Join the last chain to the first chain with a slip stitch to make a ring.



Step 2 Chain 1, make 10 sc in the ring, then slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 10 sc.



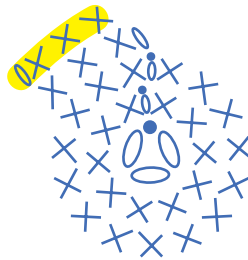
Step 3 Chain 1, *make 2 sc in the next sc, make 1 sc in the next sc; repeat from * 4 more times, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 15 sc.

Points

Five points are worked back and forth in rows around the edge of Step 3.



Step 4 Chain 1, make 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc – you'll have 3 sc.

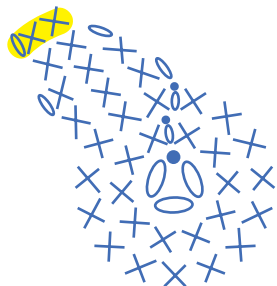


Step 5 Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of the 3 sc.

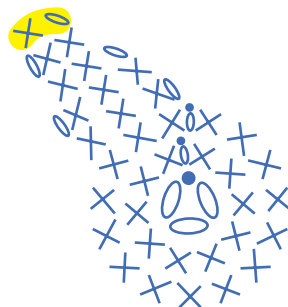


Step 6 Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in each of the last 2 sc – you'll have 2 sc.

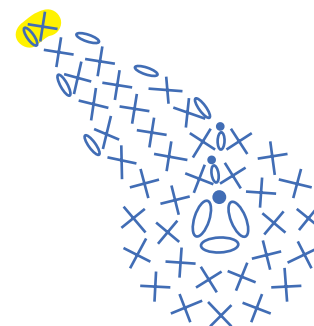
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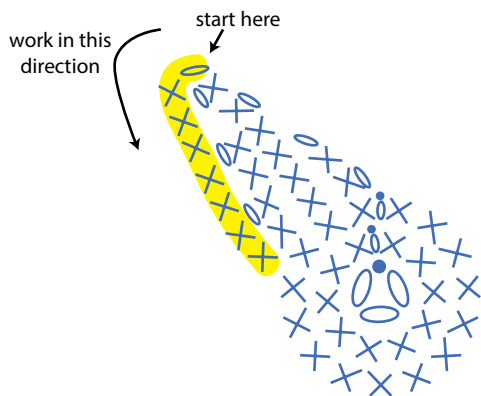
Step 7 Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of the 2 sc.



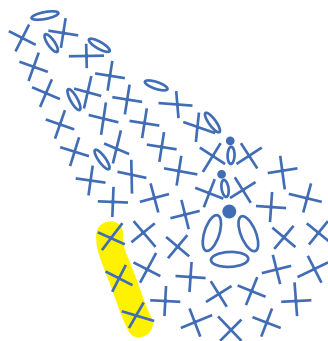
Step 8 Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in the last sc – 1 sc.



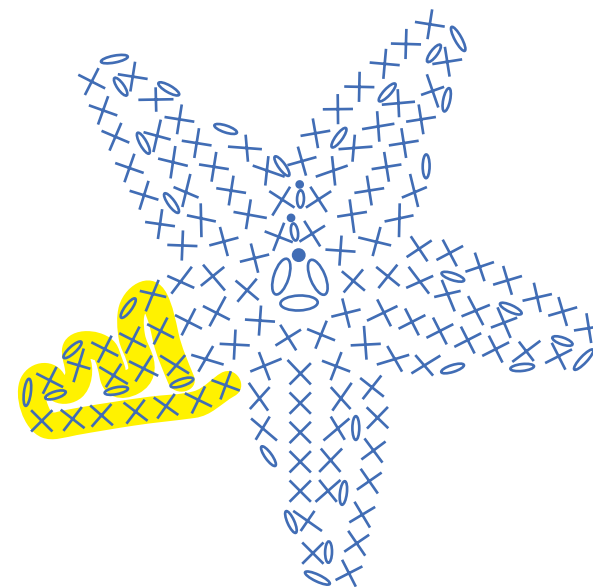
Step 9 Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in the sc.



Step 10 Chain 1, turn, make sc stitches evenly spaced along the side edge of the point.



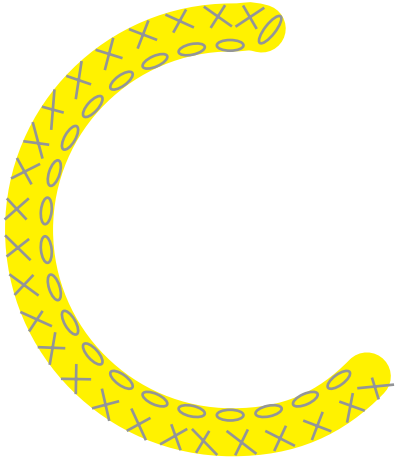
Step 11 Make 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc of Step 3.



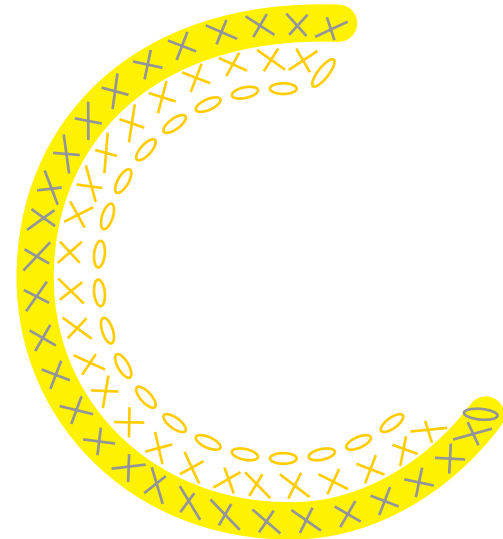
Step 12 Repeat Steps 5-11 to make a total of 4 points, then repeat Steps 5-10 to complete the 5th point.

Fasten off.

Moon

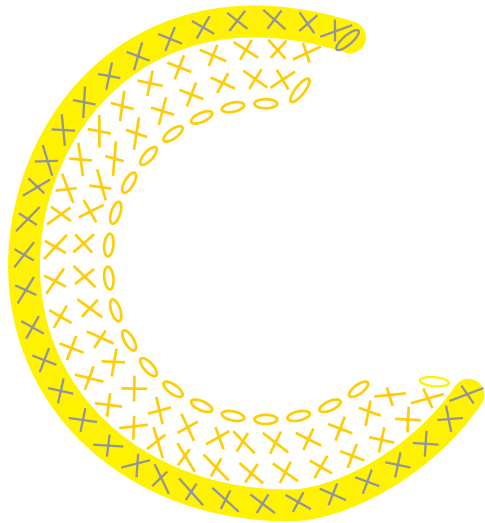


Step 1 With E, make a slip knot onto the large hook and chain 20. Make 2 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, make 1 sc in each of the next 5 chain, make 2 sc in the next chain, *make 1 sc in each of the next 3 chain, make 2 sc in the next chain; repeat from * 2 more times – you'll have 24 sc.



Step 2 Chain 1, turn, make 2 sc in the first sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 7 sc, make 2 sc in the next sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 6 sc, make 2 sc in the next sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 7 sc, make 2 sc in the last sc – you'll have 28 sc.

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Step 3 Chain 1, turn, make 2 sc in the first sc, *make 1 sc in each of the next 8 sc, make 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * 2 more times – you'll have 32 sc.

Rays

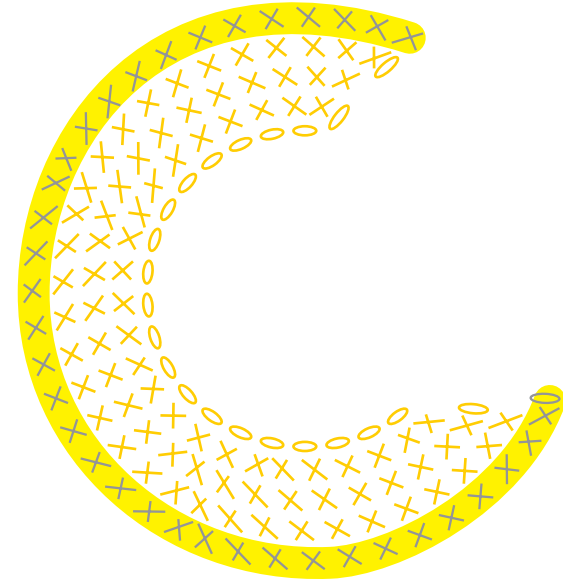
Make Rays with any of the yarn colors A-D.



Step 1 Make a slip knot onto the medium hook and make about 16-22 chain stitches.

Fasten off.

Glue yarn tails to the back of each piece.



Step 4 Chain 1, turn, make 2 sc in the first sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 9 sc, make 2 sc in the next sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 9 sc, make 2 sc in the last sc – you'll have 36 sc.

Fasten off.
