## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® - LONDON KAYE® THEME PACK (Art. #3001)  
#621 Starry Night Pack
- LION BRAND® - LONDON KAYE® HOOK WITH A TWIST™ (Art. #3002)  
#302 Medium (11.5 mm) crochet hook  
#303 Large (20 mm) crochet hook

## YOU'LL ALSO NEED

Hot glue and glue gun

## Wrap it! Glue it! Tie it!

London's designs reflect a free-spirited, improvisational approach to yarn crafting.

London uses a slip knot and just 3 stitches in her designs – a chain stitch, a slip stitch and a single crochet stitch. Watch our how-to videos at [LionBrand.com/londonkaye](http://LionBrand.com/londonkaye) for how to make a slip knot and how to do each of the 3 stitches.

Remember that London's style is big loose stitches! Don't pull your yarn tightly or try for uniform, even stitches. Our diagrams show orderly stitches. Use the diagrams to plot your course, but we encourage you to go your own way and place your stitches as you like.

Our patterns are meant to inspire you to embrace your creative spirit!

## KEY

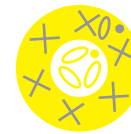
- chain

## HERE'S HOW

### Star



**Step 1** With E, make a slip knot onto the large hook and chain 3. Join the last chain to the first chain with a slip stitch to make a ring.

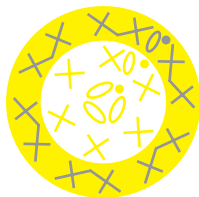


**Step 2** Chain 1, make 6 sc in the ring, then slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 6 sc.

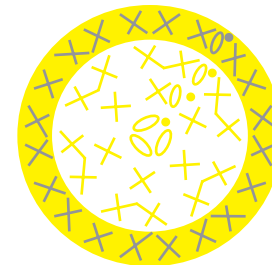
### Terms

**sc** = single crochet

**turn** = turn your piece around so that the side that was facing you is now facing away from you.

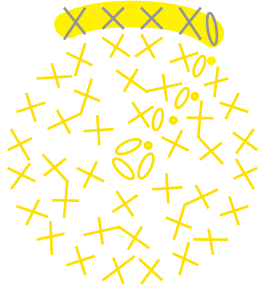


**Step 3** Chain 1, make 2 sc in each of the 6 sc around, then slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 12 sc.

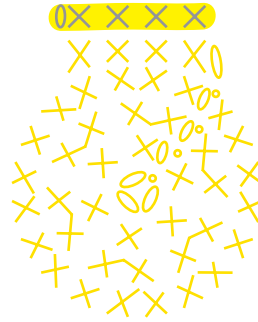


**Step 4** Chain 1, \*make 1 sc in the next sc, make 2 sc in each of the next 2 sc; repeat from \* 3 more times, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 20 sc.

**Points**



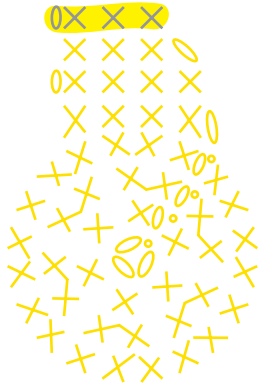
**Step 5** Chain 1, make 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc – you'll have 4 sc.



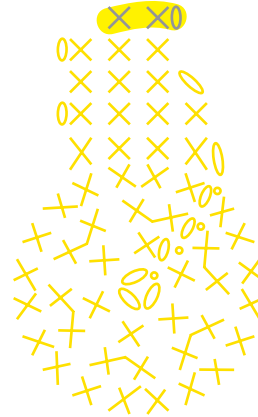
**Step 6** Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of the 4 sc.



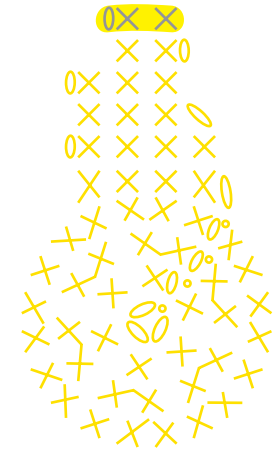
**Step 7** Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc – you'll have 3 sc.



**Step 8** Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of the 3 sc.

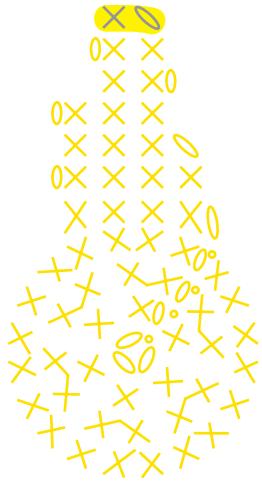


**Step 9** Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of the first 2 sc – you'll have 2 sc.

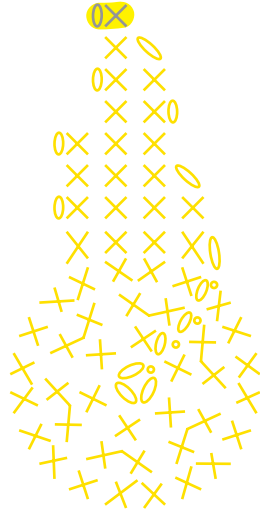


**Step 10** Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of the 2 sc.

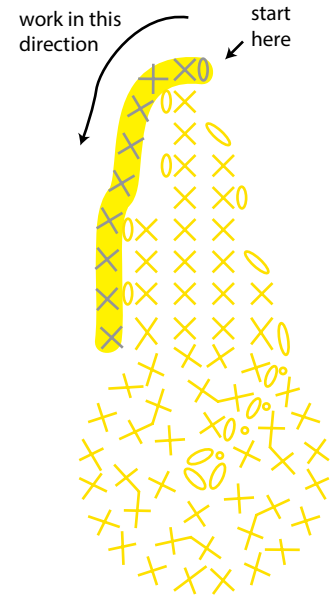
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**Step 11** Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in the last sc – 1 sc.

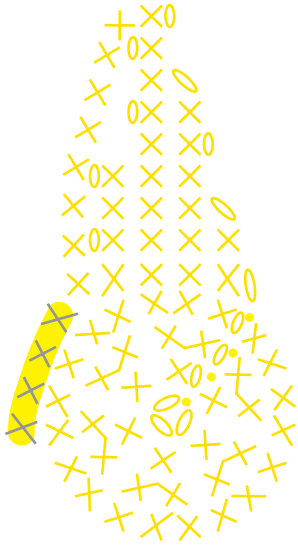


**Step 12** Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in the sc.

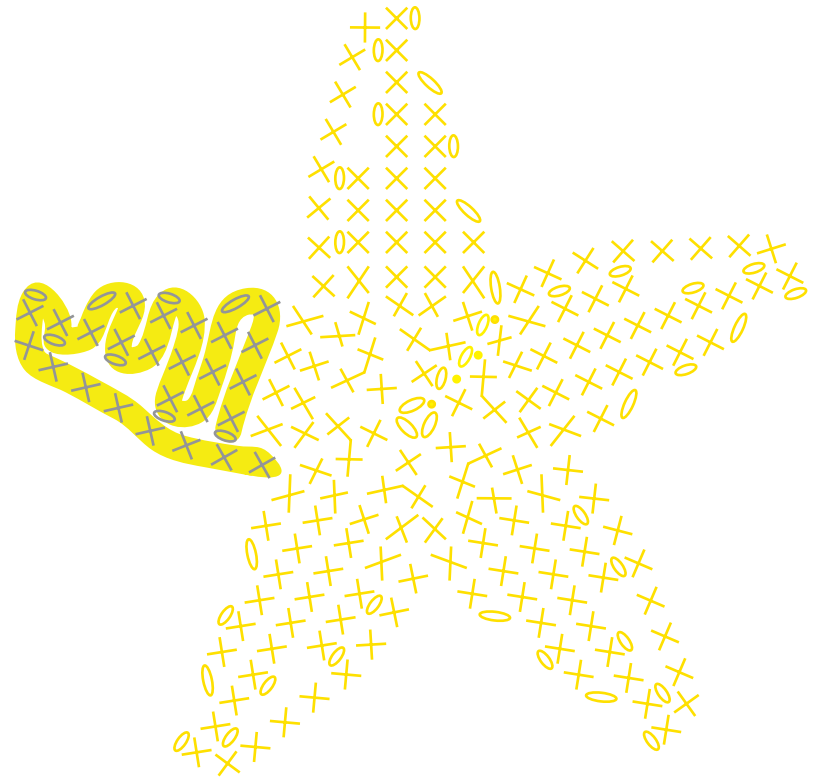


**Step 13** Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in the sc, then make sc stitches evenly spaced along the side edge of the point.

**Step 14** Make 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc of Step 4.



**Step 15** Repeat Steps 6-14 until you've made a total of 4 points, then repeat Steps 6-13 to make the 5th point. Fasten off.

### Tails

With yarn colors A-D, make as many tails as you like.



**Step 1** With yarn color of your choice, make a slip knot onto the medium hook and chain about 18-29 chain stitches. Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 sc in each of the remaining chain. Fasten off.

Step 1 makes a skinny tail.

If you'd like to make a thicker tail, instead of fastening off, work Step 2 below.



**Step 2** Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each sc across. Fasten off.

Glue yarn tails to the back of each piece.
