- LION BRAND® LONDON KAYE® HOOK WITH A TWIST™ (Art. #3002) #302 Medium (11.5 mm) crochet hook

Hot glue and glue gun

Wrap it! Glue it! Tie it!

London's designs reflect a free-spirited, improvisational approach to yarn crafting.

London uses a slip knot and just 3 stitches in her designs – a chain stitch, a slip stitch and a single crochet stitch. Watch our how-to videos at LionBrand.com/londonkaye for how to make a slip knot and how to do each of the 3 stitches.

Remember that London's style is big loose stitches! Don't pull your yarn tightly or try for uniform, even stitches. Our diagrams show orderly stitches. Use the diagrams to plot your course, but we encourage you to go your own way and place your stitches as you like.

Our patterns are meant to inspire you to embrace your creative spirit!

HERE'S HOW

Letters

Each letter is made with one or more pieces.

P is made from two pieces.




Step 1 With B, make a slip knot onto the hook and chain 8. Make 1 single crochet stitch in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 single crochet in each of the next 6 chain. Fasten off.

Terms

sc = single crochet

turn = turn your piece around so that the side that was facing you is now facing away from you.





Step 2 With B, make a slip knot onto the hook and chain 7. Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 sc in each of the next 5 chain.

Fasten off.



E is made from two pieces.



Step 3 With A, make a slip knot onto the hook and chain 14. Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 sc in each of the next 12 chain. Fasten off.



Step 4 With A, make a slip knot onto the hook and chain 5. Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 sc in each of the next 3 chain. Fasten off.

A is made from two pieces.



Step 5 With C, make a slip knot onto the hook and chain 17. Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 sc in each of the next 15 chain.


Fasten off.



Step 6 With C, make a slip knot onto the hook and chain 5. Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 sc in each of the next 3 chain.

Fasten off.

 $oldsymbol{C}$ is made from one piece.




Step 7 With D, make a slip knot onto the hook and chain 13. Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 sc in each of the next 11 chain. Fasten off.

Glue the pieces onto a bag or other item, curving to shape into letters.

Peace Sign


The peace sign is made from three pieces.



Step 8 With D, make a slip knot onto the hook and chain 37. Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 sc in each of the next 35 chain.

Fasten off.

With the yarn tails, tie the ends of Step 8 together to make a big circle.



Step 9 With D, make a slip knot onto the small hook and chain 12. Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from the hook, then make 1 sc in each of the next 10 chain. Fasten off.

Repeat Step 9 to make a second piece.

Glue yarn tails to back of pieces. Glue ends of pieces to Step 8 circle.
