## SIZE

About 10 in. (25.5 cm)

## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® - LONDON KAYE® THEME PACK (Art. #3001)  
#610 Express Yo-Self Pack
- LION BRAND® - LONDON KAYE® HOOK WITH A TWIST™ (Art. #3002)  
#301 Small (9 mm) crochet hook  
#303 Large (20 mm) crochet hook

## YOU'LL ALSO NEED

Hot glue and glue gun

## Wrap it! Glue it! Tie it!

London's designs reflect a free-spirited, improvisational approach to yarn crafting.

London uses a slip knot and just 3 stitches in her designs – a chain stitch, a slip stitch and a single crochet stitch. Watch our how-to videos at [LionBrand.com/londonkaye](http://LionBrand.com/londonkaye) for how to make a slip knot and how to do each of the 3 stitches.

Remember that London's style is big loose stitches! Don't pull your yarn tightly or try for uniform, even stitches. Our diagrams show orderly stitches. Use the diagrams to plot your course, but we encourage you to go your own way and place your stitches as you like.

Our patterns are meant to inspire you to embrace your creative spirit!

- #160 Daisy 2 balls (A)
- #153 Asphalt 1 ball (B)
- #113 Stop Sign 1 ball (C)
- #100 Snowflake 1 ball (D)

## HERE'S HOW

The yarn is sufficient to make your two favorite Emojis.

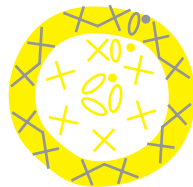


**Step 1** With A, make a slip knot onto the large hook. Chain 3. Join the last chain to the first chain with a slip stitch to make a ring.

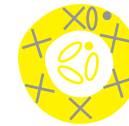
### Terms

**sc** = single crochet

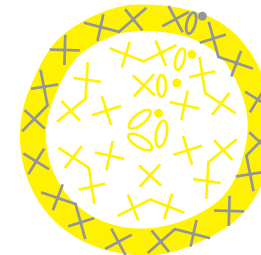
**turn** = turn your piece around so that the side that was facing you is now facing away from you.



**Step 3** Chain 1, make 2 sc in each sc around, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 12 sc.

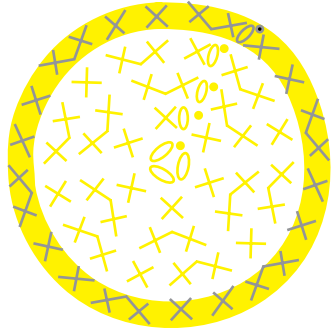


**Step 2** Chain 1, make 6 sc in the ring, then slip stitch in first sc to join.

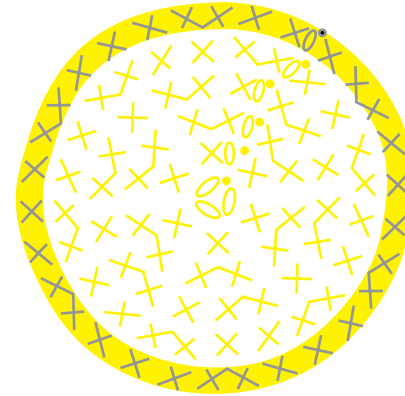


**Step 4** Chain 1, \*make 1 sc in next sc, make 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 18 sc.

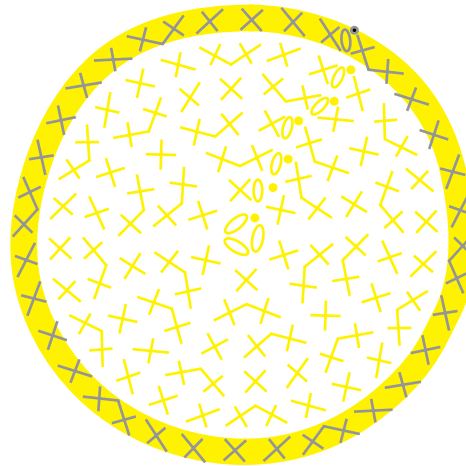

**Step 5** Chain 1, \*make 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc; repeat from \* around, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 24 sc.



**Step 6** Chain 1, make 1 sc in each of next 2 sc, \*2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in each of next 3 sc; repeat from \* to last 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in last sc, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 30 sc.



**Step 7** Chain 1, \*make 1 sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 36 sc.

Fasten off.

**FEATURES**

**Smile**



**Step 8** With B, make a slip knot onto the small hook. Make a chain about 5-8 in. (12.5-20.5 cm) long.

Fasten off and glue to Emoji.

**Dot Eyes**



**Step 9** With B, make a slip knot onto the small hook. Chain 3. Join the last chain to the first chain with a slip stitch to make a ring.

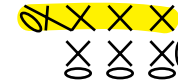
Chain 1, make 6 sc in the ring, then slip stitch in first sc to join.

Fasten off and glue to Emoji.

**Sunnies**



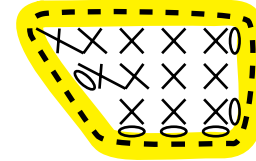
**Step 10** With B, make a slip knot onto the small hook. Chain 4. Make 1 sc into the 2nd chain from the hook and 1 sc in each of the next 2 chain – you'll have 3 sc.



**Step 11** Chain 1, turn, make 2 sc in first sc, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc – you'll have 4 sc.



**Step 12** Chain 1, turn, sc in each of first 3 sc, 2 sc in last sc – you'll have 5 sc.



**Step 13** Using the hook or your fingers, \*pull the yarn strand through to the front of your piece, then wrap the yarn strand over the edge to the back of your piece; repeat from \* along the edge. When you reach the place where you started, trim the end of the yarn and glue to the back of your piece.

Glue to Emoji.

## Heart Eyes



**Step 14** With C, make a slip knot onto the small hook. Chain 2. Make 2 sc into the 2nd chain from the hook – you'll have 2 sc.



**Step 15** Chain 1, turn, make 2 sc in first sc, 1 sc in last sc – you'll have 3 sc.



**Step 16** Chain 1, turn, make 2 sc in first sc, 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in last sc – you'll have 5 sc.

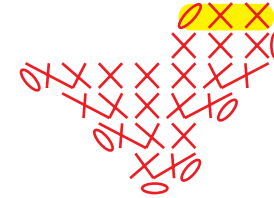


**Step 17** Chain 1, turn, make 2 sc in first sc, 1 sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in last sc – you'll have 7 sc.

**First Lobe**



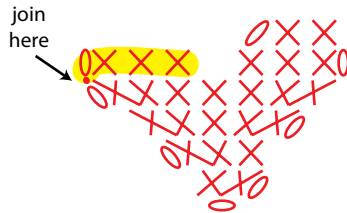
**Step 18** Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of next 3 sc – you’ll have 3 sc.



**Step 19** Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in next 2 sc – you’ll have 2 sc.

Fasten off.

**Second Lobe**



**Step 20** Join C with a slip stitch in last st of Step 17. Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of next 3 sc – 3 sc.



**Step 21** Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in next 2 sc – you’ll have 2 sc.

Fasten off, but do not cut your yarn.



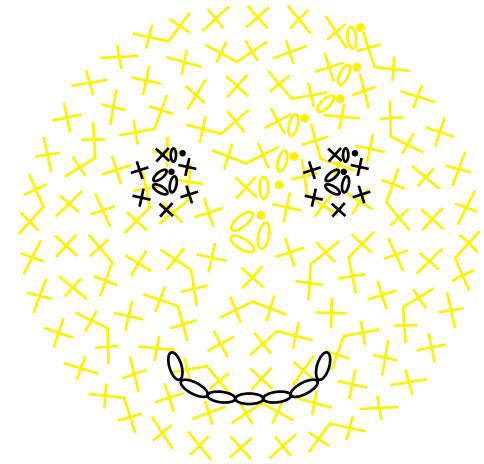
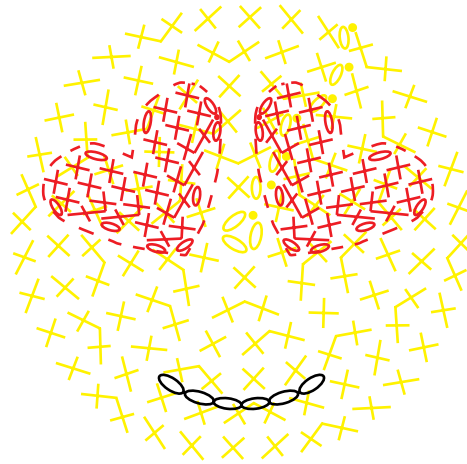
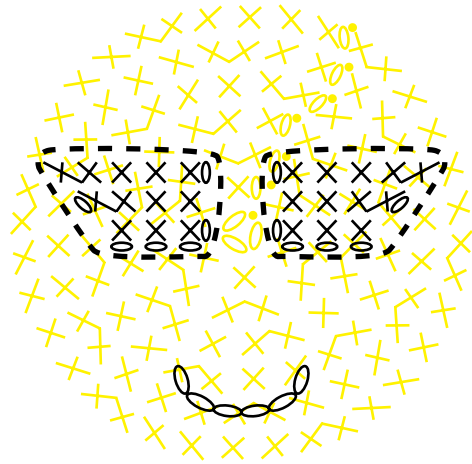
**Step 22** Using the hook or your fingers, \*pull the yarn strand through to the front of your piece, then wrap the yarn strand over the edge to the back of your piece; repeat from \* along the edge. When you reach the place where you started, trim the end of the yarn and glue to the back of your piece.

Glue to Emoji.

Glue any remaining yarn ends to the back of the Emojis.
