FISH AND SEAWEED



SIZES

Fish About 6 1/2-10 in. (16.5-25.5 cm) long

Seaweed About 7-18 in. (18-45.5 cm) long

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® - LONDON KAYE® THEME PACK (Art. #3001)
#608 Water World Pack
- LION BRAND® - LONDON KAYE® HOOK WITH A TWIST™ (Art. #3002)
#302 Medium (11.5 mm) crochet hook
#303 Large (20 mm) crochet hook

YOU'LL ALSO NEED

Hot glue and glue gun

Wrap it! Glue it! Tie it!

London's designs reflect a free-spirited, improvisational approach to yarn crafting.

London uses a slip knot and just 3 stitches in her designs – a chain stitch, a slip stitch and a single crochet stitch. Watch our how-to videos at LionBrand.com/londonkaye for how to make a slip knot and how to do each of the 3 stitches.

Remember that London's style is big loose stitches! Don't pull your yarn tightly or try for uniform, even stitches. Our diagrams show orderly stitches. Use the diagrams to plot your course, but we encourage you to go your own way and place your stitches as you like.

Our patterns are meant to inspire you to embrace your creative spirit!

HERE'S HOW

London made 5 pieces of Thin Seaweed and 2 pieces of Thick Seaweed. Use the directions below, then make as many pieces as you like!

Thin Seaweed



Step 1 With C, make a slip knot onto the large hook and chain 18. Make 1 single crochet in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 single crochet in each of the next 16 chain – you'll have 17 single crochet stitches.



Step 2 Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of the first 11 sc, slip stitch in the next sc. Fasten off.

To make the next 4 pieces of Thin Seaweed, simply repeat Steps 1 and 2, following the table below:

Terms

sc = single crochet

turn = turn your piece around so that the side that was facing you is now facing away from you.

Yarn Color	Beginning Chains	Number of sc you'll have in Step 1	Number of sc to make in Step 2 (before making the slip stitch)
C	16	15	10
B	14	13	9
B	14	13	9
B	9	8	4

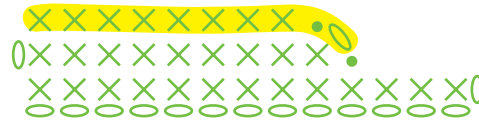
Thick Seaweed



Step 3 With C, make a slip knot onto the large hook and chain 14. Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 sc in each of the next 12 chain – you’ll have 13 sc.



Step 4 Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of the first 9 sc, slip stitch in the next sc.



Step 5 Chain 1, turn, skip the slip stitch, slip stitch in the next sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 8 sc. Fasten off.

With A, repeat Steps 3-5 to make second piece of Thick Seaweed.

Big Fish

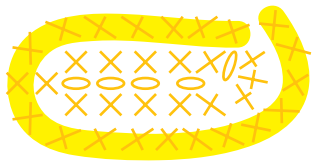


Step 6 With D, make a slip knot onto the medium hook and chain 5.

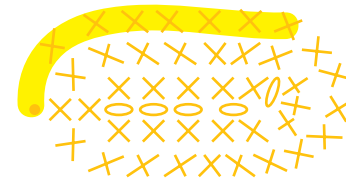
Make 2 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, make 1 sc in each of the next 2 chain, make 3 sc in the last chain – you'll have 7 sc.



Step 7 Continuing in the same direction, make 4 sc evenly spaced along lower edge of Fish, then make 3 sc in end of piece – you'll have 14 sc.



Step 8 Continuing in the same direction, make 1 sc in the next sc, make 2 sc in the next sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc, make 3 sc in the next sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc, make 2 sc in the next sc, make 1 sc in the next sc, make 2 sc in the next sc, make 1 sc in the next sc, make 2 sc in the next sc – you'll have 20 sc.



Step 9 Continuing in the same direction, make 1 sc in each of the next 7 sc, slip stitch in the next sc.
Fasten off.

Tail



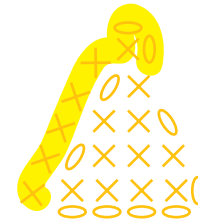
Step 10 With D, make a slip knot onto the medium hook and chain 5.
Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 sc in each of the next 3 chain – you'll have 4 sc.



Step 12 Repeat Step 11 twice more – you'll have 1 sc remaining.



Step 11 Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in each of the remaining sc – you'll have 3 sc.



Step 13 Chain 2, turn, make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make sc stitches evenly spaced along the side edge of the tail.
Fasten off.

Glue tail to Fish.

Eye

With B, make a slip knot onto the medium hook and chain 2.
Fasten off.
Tie the chain into a knot and glue to Fish.

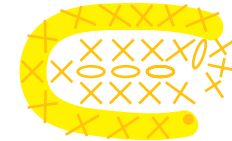
Medium Fish (make 1 with D and 1 with E)



Step 14 With D, make a slip knot onto the small hook and chain 4.
Make 2 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, make 1 sc in the next chain, make 3 sc in the last chain – you'll have 6 sc.



Step 15 Continuing in the same direction, make 3 sc evenly spaced along lower edge of Fish, 3 sc in end of piece – you'll have 12 sc.



Step 16 Continuing in the same direction, make 1 sc in the next sc, make 2 sc in the next sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, make 3 sc in the next sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc, slip stitch in the next sc.
Fasten off.

Tail



Step 17 With D, make a slip knot onto the medium hook and chain 4. Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 sc in each of the next 2 chain – you'll have 3 sc.



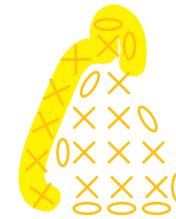
Step 18 Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each sc across.



Step 19 Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc – you'll have 2 sc.



Step 20 Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in the next sc – you'll have 1 sc.



Step 21 Chain 2, turn, make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make sc stitches evenly spaced along the side edge of the tail. Fasten off.

Glue tail to Fish.

Eye

With B, make a slip knot onto the medium hook and chain 2. Fasten off. Tie the chain into a knot and glue to Fish.

Small Fish



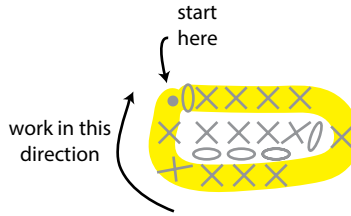
Step 22 With E, make a slip knot onto the medium hook and chain 4. Make 2 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 sc in each of the next 2 chain - you'll have 4 sc.



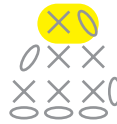
Step 25 Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc - you'll have 2 sc.

Eye

Cut a short length of B. Tie into a knot, trim ends and glue to Fish for eye.
Glue yarn tails to the back of pieces.
Glue some of the pieces of Seaweed together, then glue some of the Fish on top of the Seaweed.



Step 23 Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc; continuing in the same direction, make 1 sc in end of Fish, make 5 sc evenly spaced along lower edge of Fish, chain 1, slip stitch in beginning chain to join. Fasten off.

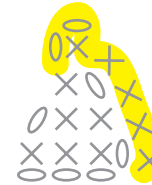


Step 26 Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in the next sc - you'll have 1 sc.

Tail



Step 24 With E, make a slip knot onto the medium hook and chain 4. Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, make 1 sc in each of the next 2 chain - you'll have 3 sc.



Step 27 With E, chain 2, turn, make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from hook, then make sc stitches evenly spaced along the side edge of the tail. Fasten off.

Glue tail to Fish.

Make one more small fish with E and one with D.
