About 12 x 16 in. (30.5 x 40.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® LONDON KAYE® THEME PACK (Art. #3001) #604 London Eye Pack
- LION BRAND® LONDON KAYE® HOOK WITH A TWIST™ (Art. #3002) #302 Medium (11.5 mm) crochet hook

YOU'LL ALSO NEED Hot glue and glue gun

Wrap it! Glue it! Tie it!

London's designs reflect a free–spirited, improvisational approach to yarn crafting.

London uses a slip knot and just 3 stitches in her designs – a chain stitch, a slip stitch and a single crochet stitch. Watch our how-to videos at LionBrand.com/londonkaye for how to make a slip knot and how to do each of the 3 stitches.

Remember that London's style is big loose stitches! Don't pull your yarn tightly or try for uniform, even stitches. Our diagrams show orderly stitches. Use the diagrams to plot your course, but we encourage you to go your own way and place your stitches as you like.

Our patterns are meant to inspire you to embrace your creative spirit!

HERE'S HOW

Step 1 With A, make a slip knot onto the hook. Chain 3.

Join the end of the chain to the beginning of the chain with a slip stitch to make a ring.

Terms

sc = single crochet

turn = turn your piece around so that the side that was facing you is now facing away from you.



Step 3 Chain 1, make 2 sc in each sc around, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 12 sc.

Step 2 Chain 1, make 6 sc in the ring, then slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 6 sc.



Step 4 Chain 1, *make 1 sc in next sc, make 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 18 sc.

Fasten off.





Step 5 Join B with a slip stitch in any sc along outside edge of the pupil.

Chain 1, *make 1 sc in each of next 2 sc, make 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around the pupil, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 24 sc.



Step 6 Chain 1, *make 2 sc in next sc, make 1 sc in each of next 3 sc; repeat from * around, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 30 sc.



Step 7 Chain 1, make 1 sc in each of next 2 sc, make 2 sc in next sc, *make 1 sc in each of next 4 sc, make 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * to last 2 sc, make 1 sc in each of last 2 sc, slip stitch in first sc to join – you'll have 36 sc.

Fasten off.

White of the Eye

Join D with a slip stitch in any sc along the outside edge of the iris.





Step 8 Chain 1, make 1 sc in each of next 9 sc – you'll have 9 sc.



Step 9 Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in each of the remaining sc – you'll have 8 sc.



Step 10 Repeat Step 9 for 5 more times – you'll have 3 sc remaining.





Step 11 Chain 1, turn, skip the first sc, make 1 sc in next sc, slip st in last sc.

Fasten off.

To make the opposite side of the white of the Eye, skip 9 sc along the edge of the iris, then join D with a slip stitch in the next sc.

Step 12 Repeat Steps 8-11 to work opposite side of the white of the Eye.

Do not fasten off.





Step 13 With D, chain 1, make sc stitches evenly spaced all the way around the outside edge of the Eye, slip stitch in first sc to join. Fasten off.





Step 14 Join A with a slip stitch in one corner of Eye. Chain 1, then make sc stitches evenly spaced along lower edge up to opposite corner of Eye – making 2 sc in 1 sc if needed to keep your piece flat.



When you create the outline along the top edge of the Eye, you'll also be making lashes. London made 6 lashes – but you can make as many as you like!

Step 15 With A, make sc stitches evenly spaced along the top edge of the Eye, stopping at each point where you'd like to add a lash.

For each lash, chain 3-6 (as you like, the chain length creates the length of each lash), then make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from the hook and make 1 sc in each of the remaining chains – working back down to the top edge of the Eye.

Finish making sc stitches evenly spaced along the top edge of the Eye, adding 5 more lashes as you go. When you reach the corner of the Eye, slip stitch in first sc to join.

Fasten off.

Glue yarn tails to the back of the Eye.
