# Wrap it! Glue it! Tie it!

London's designs reflect a free–spirited, improvisational approach to yarn crafting.

London uses a slip knot and just 3 stitches in her designs – a chain stitch, a slip stitch and a single crochet stitch. Watch our how-to videos at LionBrand.com/londonkaye for how to make a slip knot and how to do each of the 3 stitches.

Remember that London's style is big loose stitches! Don't pull your yarn tightly or try for uniform, even stitches. Our diagrams show orderly stitches. Use the diagrams to plot your course, but we encourage you to go your own way and place your stitches as you like.

Our patterns are meant to inspire you to embrace your creative spirit!

# **HERE'S HOW**

Body

**Step 1** With E, make a slip knot onto the large hook and chain 15.

Make 1 single crochet in the 2nd chain from hook, then make 1 single crochet in each of the next 13 chain – you'll have 14 single crochet stitches.

## Terms


**sc** = single crochet

**turn** = turn your piece around so that the side that was facing you is now facing away from you.

**Step 2** Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of the 14 sc. Fasten off.

# Antenna

slip stitch

🔿 chain

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
**Step 3** With small hook, join E with a slip stitch into one of the corners of the body. Chain 8. Fasten off.

Repeat Step 3 to make a second antenna.

# Upper Wings (make 2)

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With C, make a slip knot onto the large hook and chain 7.




**Step 4** Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from the hook and 1 sc in each of the next 4 chain, then make 3 sc in the next chain; working around the wing towards where you started Step 4, make 1 sc in each of the next 4 chain and 2 sc in the last chain – you'll have 14 sc.




**Step 5** Make 2 sc in the first sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, 2 sc in each of the next 3 sc, 1 sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in the next sc – you'll have 18 sc. Fasten off.

work in this direction




**Step 6** With large hook, join D with a slip stitch in the 3rd sc from Step 5, chain 1, make 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc, 2 sc in the next sc, 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, 2 sc in the next sc, 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc, slip stitch in the next sc – you'll have 12 sc.




**Step 7** Chain 1, turn, skip the slip stitch, slip stitch in the next sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, 2 sc in the next sc, 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, 2 sc in the next sc, slip stitch in each of the next 2 sc – you'll have 8 sc.






**Step 8** Chain 1, turn, skip the next 2 slip stitches, make 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, 2 sc in the next sc, 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, slip stitch in the next sc – you'll have 8 sc.

**Tip** On Step 9, by working more or fewer sc stitches around the wing, you can shape the wing – experiment to find a look that you like.



**Step 9** Chain 1, turn, make sc stitches evenly spaced around the wing, slip stitch in first sc to join. Fasten off.




**Step 10** With large hook, join B with a slip stitch at the beginning of the wider end of the wing, \*sc in next 2 sc, turn, sc in first sc, turn, work slip stitches evenly along side of rows worked in this step to next sc of Step 9; repeat from \* 2 more times, slip stitch in next sc of Step 9. Fasten off.



# Lower Wings (make 2)


With C, make a slip knot onto the large hook and chain 6.



**Step 11** Make 1 sc in the 2nd chain from the hook and 1 sc in each of the next 3 chain, make 3 sc in the last chain; working around the wing towards where you started Step 11, make 1 sc in each of the next 3 ch and 2 sc in the last chain – you'll have 12 sc.



**Step 12** Continuing in the same direction, make 2 sc in the first sc of Step 11 and 1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, make 2 sc in the next sc, slip stitch in the next sc – you'll have 8 sc. Fasten off.



**Step 13** With large hook, join B with a slip stitch in the 2nd sc from Step 12.

Chain 1, make 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc, make 2 sc in the next sc, 1 sc in the next sc, 2 sc in the next sc, 1 sc in the next sc, slip stitch in the next sc – you'll have 9 sc.



**Step 14** Chain 1, turn, skip the slip stitch and the first sc, make 1 sc in each of the next 5 sc, make 2 sc in the next sc, slip stitch in the next sc – you'll have 7 sc.






Step 15 Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of the 7 sc.



Step 16 Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of 7 sc.




**Step 17** Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each of 7 sc. Fasten off.




**Step 18** With large hook, join A with a slip stitch in the last sc of Step 17 so that you can work along the lower edge of the wing. Chain 1, make sc stitches evenly spaced along lower edge of the wing, slip stitch in end of wing.






Step 19 Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each sc of Step 18.



**Step 20** Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each sc to the last 2 sc of Step 19, slip stitch in the next sc.



**Step 21** Chain 1, turn, make 1 sc in each sc of Step 20, chain 1, then make sc stitches evenly spaced along outside edge of wing. Fasten off.

Glue the wings to the body. Glue the yarn tails to the back of the Butterfly.
