# SKILL LEVEL - Easy

### SIZE

About 8 x 64 in. (20.5 x 162.5 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Hometown USA® (Art. #135)
  - 153 Oakland Black 2 balls (A)
  - 149 Dallas Grey 1 ball (B)
  - 114 Tampa Spice 1 ball (C)
  - 172 Oklahoma City Green 1 ball (D)
  - 109 Fort Worth Blue 1 ball (E)
  - 175 Montpelier Peacock 1 ball (F)
  - 136 Portsmouth Pumpkin 1 ball (G)
  - 159 Madison Mustard 1 ball (H)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size N (10 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



# **GAUGE**

One Square = about 8 x 8 in. (20.5 x 20.5 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### **NOTES**

- 1. 8 Squares are worked separately, then sewn together to make the Scarf.
- 2. Each Square is worked in joined rnds with the right side always facing.
- 3. Rounds 1-3 are worked with yarn colors B, C, D, E, F, G, and H, as desired. Round 4 is worked with A.
- 4. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram for the Square.

### SQUARES (make 8)

Rnd 1: With any color except A, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – you will have 12 dc and 4 ch-2 sps.

Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join 2nd yarn color with a sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, \*ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made); rep from \* 2 more times, ch 1, 3 dc again in first ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 24 dc, 4 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (2 (3-dc groups) and 1 ch-1 sp along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off.

**Note:** To maintain the square shape, join each new yarn color in a different corner ch-2 sp.

Rnd 3: Join 3rd yarn color with a sl st in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, \*ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc again in first corner ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 36 dc, 8 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (3 (3-dc groups) and 2 ch-1 sps along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Rnd 4: Join A with a sl st in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, \*(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, 3 dc again in first corner ch-2 sp, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 48 dc, 8 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (4 (3-dc groups) and 3 ch-1 sps along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

## **FINISHING**

Fasten off.

Sew Squares together to make the Scarf.

Weave in yarn ends.
