SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

Finished Circumference About 24 1/2 in. (62 cm)

Finished Height About 9 in. (23 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Touch of Mohair (Art. #677)
 - 135 Burnt Orange 1 ball (A)
 - 139 Lilac Rose 1 ball (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size G-6 (4 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

4 shells = about 4 1/2 in. (11.5 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

beg half-shell Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in top of beg ch.

half-shell Work 3 dc in indicated st or sp.

shell Work 5 dc in indicated st or sp.

NOTES

1. Cowl is made in one piece, then sewn together to make a ring.
2. The yarn color is changed on every row but piece is only turned on every other row. Follow the pattern carefully and turn piece only when instructed.
3. Because the piece is only turned on every other row, the yarn color is changed using different methods for A and for B.
 - a. To change to A, work last st of B to last yarn over. Drop B. Return dropped loop of A to hook and draw through all loops to complete the last st. Turn the piece and proceed with A.
 - b. To change to B, remove the loop of A from hook and enlarge it or place it on a stitch marker or safety pin so that it does not unravel. Do not turn the piece. Return to the beginning of the row just completed, insert hook in top of beg ch, yarn over with dropped strand of B and draw up a loop. Proceed with B.
4. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

COWL

With A, ch 44.

Row 1 (RS): With A, shell in 6th ch from hook (5 skipped ch count as 2 base ch and first dc), *sk next 4 ch, shell in next ch; rep from * to last 3 ch, sk 2 ch, dc in last ch – you will have 8 shells and 1 dc at beg and end of this row. Change to B.

Row 2 (RS): With B, do not turn, beg half-shell in top of beg ch-3, shell in each sp between shells across, half-shell in last dc – 7 shells and 2 half-shells. Change to A.

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Row 3 (WS): With A, ch 3, turn, shell in each sp between shells across, dc in top of beg ch-3 – 8 shells and 1 dc at beg and end of row. Change to B.

Row 4 (WS): From WS with B, do not turn, beg half-shell in top of beg ch-3, shell in each sp between shells across, half-shell in last dc – 7 shells and 2 half-shells. Change to A.

Row 5 (RS): With A, ch 3, turn, shell in each sp between shells across, dc in top of beg ch-3 – 8 shells and 1 dc at beg and end of row. Change to B.

Row 6 (RS): From RS with B, do not turn, beg half-shell in top of beg ch-3, shell in each sp between shells across, half-shell in last dc – 7 shells and 2 half-shells. Change to A.

Rep Rows 3-6, turning piece every other row, until piece measures about 24 1/2 in. (62 cm) from beg, end with a Row 4 or a Row 6 as the last row you work.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for seaming.

FINISHING

Sew short ends of piece together to make Cowl.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

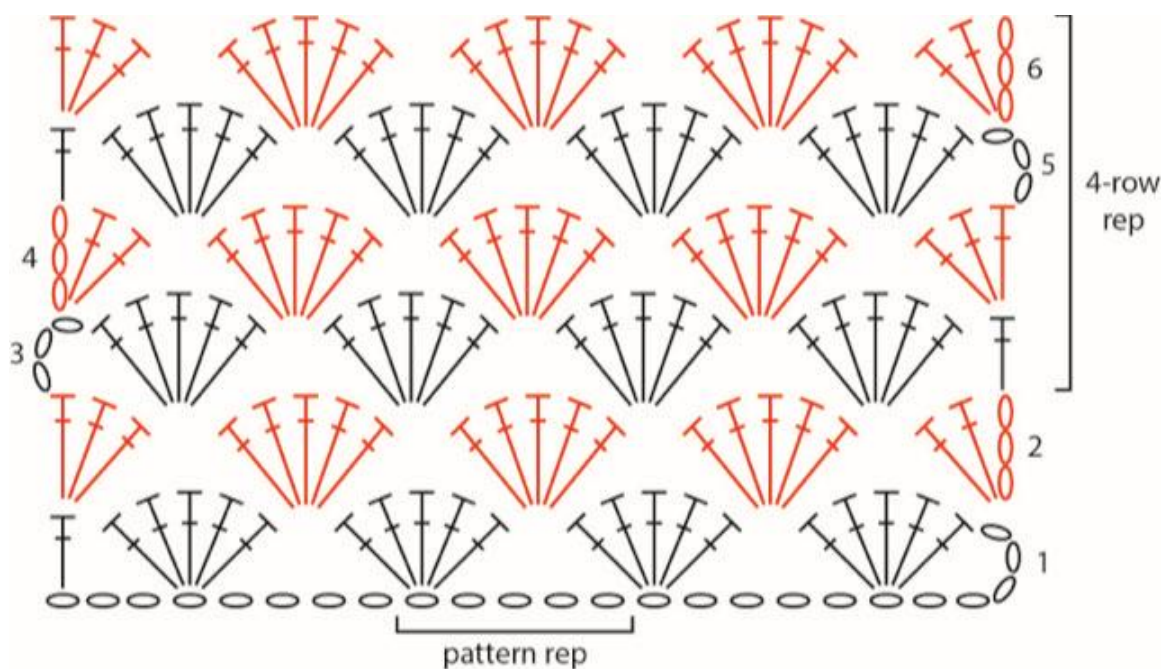
RS = right side

sk = skip

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
