SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

About 20 x 65 in. (51 x 165 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Touch of Merino (Art. #676)
 - 133 Amberglow 1 ball (A)
 - 098 Gardenia 1 ball (B)
 - 113 Beet Red 1 ball (C)
 - 150 Oxford Grey 1 ball (D)
 - 153 Black 1 ball (E)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 4 (3.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

21 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Block I.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Shawl is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows.
2. The design of the Shawl is 5 blocks, each block in a different stitch pattern and yarn color.
3. Side borders are worked in one with the Shawl.

Border pattern

On both RS and WS rows, work the first and last 3 sts as follows:

Slip the first st as if to purl, k2; work in block pattern to last 3 sts, k2, p1.

SHAWL

Block I

With A, cast on 104 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Slip first st as if to purl, k2, place marker, k to last 3 sts, place marker, k2, p1.

Rows 2-5: Work in border pattern to marker, slip marker, k to next marker, slip marker, work in border pattern to end.

Row 6: Work in border pattern to marker, slip marker, p to next marker, slip marker, work in border pattern to end.

Row 7: Work in border pattern to marker, slip marker, *yo, k2tog, k2; rep from * to 2 sts before marker, yo, k2tog, slip marker, work in border pattern to end.

Rows 8 and 9: Rep Rows 6 and 7.

Row 10: Rep Row 6.

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Rows 11-160: Rep Rows 1-10 for 15 more times.

Block II

Change to B.

Row 1 (RS): Work in border pattern to marker, slip marker, k to next marker, slip marker, work in border pattern to end.

Rows 2-4: Work in border pattern to marker, slip marker, *p1, k1; rep from * to next marker, slip marker, work in border pattern to end.

Row 5: Rep Row 1.

Rows 6-8: Work in border pattern to marker, slip marker, *k1, p1; rep from * to next marker, slip marker, work in border pattern to end.

Rep Rows 1-8 until Block II measures about 9 in. (23 cm), end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Block III

Change to C.

Row 1 (RS): Work in border pattern to marker, slip marker, k to next marker, slip marker, work in border pattern to end.

Rows 2-4: Rep Row 1.

Row 5: Work in border pattern to marker, slip marker, *yo, k2tog, k2; rep from * to 2 sts before marker, yo, k2tog, slip marker, work in border pattern to end.

Rows 6-10: Rep Row 1.

Row 11: Work in border pattern to marker, slip marker, k2, *yo, k2tog, k2; rep from * to next marker, slip marker, work in border pattern to end.

Row 12: Rep Row 1.

Rows 13-120: Rep Rows 1-12 for 9 more times.

Rows 121-126: Rep Rows 1-6.

Block IV

Change to D.

Row 1 (RS): Work in border pattern to marker, slip marker, k to next marker, slip marker, work in border pattern to end.

Row 2: Work in border pattern to marker, slip marker, p to next marker, slip marker, work in border pattern to end.

Rows 3 and 4: Rep Row 1.

Rows 5-108: Rep Rows 1-4 for 26 more times.

Block V

Change to E.

Row 1 (RS): Work in border pattern to marker, slip marker, k to next marker, slip marker, work in border pattern to end.

Rows 2 and 3: Rep Row 1.

Row 4: Work in border pattern to marker, slip marker, *yo, p2tog; rep from * to next marker, slip marker, work in border pattern to end.

Rows 5-76: Rep Rows 1-4 for 18 more times.

Rows 77 and 78: Rep Row 1.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

rep = repeat

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)

yo = yarn over
