# SKILL LEVEL - Easy+

# **SIZES**

S (M/L, 1X/2X)

Finished Bust About 41 (48, 57) in. (104 (122, 145) cm)

Finished Length About 25 (26, 26 1/2) in. (63.5 (66, 67.5) cm)

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

# **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Touch of Mohair (Art. #677)
  - 098 Gardenia 3 (4, 5) balls (A)
  - 150 Oxford Grey 1 (2, 2) ball(s) (B)
  - 148 Mosaic Blue 1 (1, 2) ball(s) (C)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

# **GAUGE**

7 pattern reps = about 8 in. (20.5 cm); 17 rows = about 6 1/4 in. (16 cm). **Note:** One pattern rep on RS rows consists of one 3-dc group and the following sc. One pattern rep on WS rows consists of (ch 2, sc, ch 5, sc). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### **NOTES**

- 1. The Back and Front of the Pullover are worked separately.
- 2. The Sleeves are worked in one with the Back and the Front.
- 3. The yarn color is changed following a Stripe Sequence. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the stitch. Proceed with new yarn color. Fasten off old color.
- 4. Pullover was designed with an opening on each upper arm.
- 5. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

### STRIPE SEQUENCE

Work 3 rows with A, \*2 rows with B, 4 rows with A, 2 rows B, 2 rows A, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with B, and 4 rows with A; rep from \* for Stripe Sequence.

### **BACK**

With A, ch 88 (108, 128).

**Row 1 (WS):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch, ch 5, sk next ch, sc in next ch, \*ch 2, sk next 2 ch, sc in next ch, ch 5, sk next ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, ch 1, sk next ch, sc in last ch – you will have 36 (44, 52) sc, 17 (21, 25) ch-5 sps, 16 (20, 24) ch-2 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps.

**Row 2 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first ch-1 sp (beginning ch-3 and following 2 dc count as first 3-dc group), sc in next ch-5 sp, \*3 dc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next ch-5 sp; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, 2 dc in last ch-1 sp, dc in last sc (last dc and previous 2 dc count as last 3-dc group) – 18 (22, 26) 3-dc groups and 17 (21, 25) sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st, ch 5, sk next st, sc in next st, \*ch 2, sk next st, sc in next st, ch 5, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from \* to last 2 sts, ch 1, sk next st, sc in top of beginning ch-3 and change to B - 36 (44, 52) sc, 17 (21, 25) ch-5 sps, 16 (20, 24) ch-2 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps.

**Rows 4-45:** Rep Rows 2 and 3 for 21 times, changing yarn color following Stripe Sequence.

**Row 46:** Rep Row 2, continuing to change yarn color following Stripe Sequence. Do not fasten off.

# Shape Sleeves

As you work the remainder of the Back, continue to change yarn color following the Stripe Sequence unless otherwise noted.

Drop loop from hook but do not fasten off. Elongate loop or place it on a stitch marker or safety pin so that it does not unravel. From WS, with a separate length of A, join A with sl st in top of Row 46 beginning ch-3, ch 49 (44, 39) for sleeve ch. Fasten off. From RS, return dropped loop to hook and gently tighten loop around hook.

**Row 1 (WS):** Ch 50 (45, 40) for sleeve ch, turn, sc in 2nd ch from hook, ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch, \*ch 5, sk next ch, sc in next ch, ch 2, sk next 2 ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* to last ch, ch 5, sk last ch; working over sts of Row 46, sc in next dc, \*\*ch 2, sk next st, sc in next st, ch 5, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from \*\* to last 2 sts, ch 2, sk next st, sc in top of beginning ch-3; working over 2nd sleeve ch, ch 5, sk next ch, sc in next ch, \*\*\*ch 2, sk next 2 ch, sc in next ch, ch 5, sk next ch, sc in next ch; rep from \*\*\* to last 2 ch, ch 1, sk next ch, sc in last ch – 76 (80, 84) sc, 37 (39, 41) ch-5 sps, 36 (38, 40) ch-2 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first ch-1 sp, sc in next ch-5 sp, \*3 dc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next ch-5 sp; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, 2 dc in last ch-1 sp, dc in last sc - 38 (40, 42) 3-dc groups and 37 (39, 41) sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st, ch 5, sk next st, sc in next st, \*ch 2, sk next st, sc in next st, ch 5, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from \* to last 2 sts, ch 1, sk next st, sc in top of beginning ch-3.

Rows 4-17 (19, 21): Rep Rows 2 and 3 for 7 (8, 9) more times. For sizes S and 1X/2X change to C in last st of last row. For size M/L change to A in last st of last row.

# Sizes S and 1X/2X ONLY

**Next 2 Rows:** With C, rep Rows 2 and 3; change to A in last st of last row. Fasten off C.

Next 2 Rows: With A, rep Rows 2 and 3.

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Last Row: With A, rep Row 2.

Fasten off A.

# Size M/L ONLY

Next 4 Rows: With A, rep Rows 2 and 3; change to C in last st of last row.

Fasten off A.

Last Row: With C, rep Row 2.

Fasten off C.

### **FRONT**

Make same as Back.

# **FINISHING**

# Join Shoulders and Tops of Sleeves

Hold Front and Back with RS together and matching sts along top edges.

From WS and working through both thicknesses, join A with sc in first st at one top corner, (ch 3, sc in next sc) 6 (7, 8) times.

Fasten off.

Skip next six 3-dc groups for sleeve opening, then join A with sc in next sc. (Ch 3, sc in next sc) 3 times.

Fasten off.

Leaving eight 3-dc groups at center of top edge un-joined for neck, join opposite shoulder and sleeve in same way as first.

# Join Side and Sleeve Edges

With RS of Front and Back together and matching row ends of sides and sleeve chains, join A with sc in end of first sc row at one lower corner.

Working through both thicknesses, \*ch 3, sk end of next row, sc in end of next row; rep from \* to last row before beg of sleeve ch, ch 3, sk end of last row. Working along opposite side of sleeve foundation ch, sc in ch at base of first sc, \*\*ch 3, sc in ch at base of next sc; rep from \*\* across.

Fasten off.

Beginning at opposite lower corner, join opposite side of side and sleeve in same way.

Weave in ends.
