SKILL LEVEL - EASY

SIZE About 40 x 52 in. (101.5 x 132 cm)

MATERIALS

• LION BRAND® CUPCAKE® (Art. #935)

#215 Happy Dance 1 cake (A) #211 Beach Ball 1 cake (B) #208 Peas and Carrots 1 cake (C) #203 Jelly Bean 1 cake (D)



- LION BRAND® crochet hook size G-6 (4.25 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

<u>GAUGE</u>

15 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm); 13 rows = about 4 1/2 in. (11.5 cm) BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Puff (worked all in one st) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop, (yarn over, insert hook in *same* st, yarn over and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over, draw through all 7 loops on hook.

<u>NOTES</u>

- 1. Three Panels are worked separately, then sewn together to make the Afghan.
- 2. Each Panel is worked back and forth in rows in one color of yarn.
- 3. An edging is worked along both long side edges of Center Panel and borders along the outside edges of the Side Panels.
- 4. For those who find visuals helpful, we've provided stitch diagrams.

Note: The following corrections have been incorporated into the pattern below. We are highlighting the corrections separately here so that if you have printed out an earlier version of the pattern you'll know what was changed.

CORRECTIONS (applied January 16th, 2019)

Edging

Row 4: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, *hdc in next st, Puff in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to beg ch, hdc in 2nd ch of beg ch-3 – 101 hdc and 100 Puffs.

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CENTER PANEL

With A, ch 42.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – you will have 41 sc in this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in next 18 sts, ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next st, ch 1, sk next st, hdc in last 19 sts – 39 hdc and 2 ch-1 sps.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in next 18 sts, Puff in next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st, Puff in next ch-1 sp, hdc in next 18 sts, hdc in top of beg ch-2 – 41 sts.

Row 4: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in next 18 sts, ch 1, sk next Puff, hdc in next st, ch 1, sk next Puff, hdc in next 18 sts, hdc in top of beg ch-2. **Rows 5-150:** Rep Rows 3 and 4 for 73 more times. Fasten off.

Edging

From RS, join D with a sl st in any corner so that you are ready to work along a long side edge.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, work 201 sc evenly spaced along long edge.

To work 201 sc evenly spaced along a long edge, work 4 sc spaced evenly over each group of 3 rows, working 5 sc over the last group of 3 rows.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, sk first 2 sts, hdc in next st, *ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next st; rep from * across working last hdc in top of beg ch-2 – 101 hdc and 100 ch-1 sps.

Row 4: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, *hdc in next st, Puff in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to beg ch, hdc in 2nd ch of beg ch-3 – 101 hdc and 100 Puffs. **Rows 5 and 6:** Rep Rows 3 and 4.

Row 7: Rep Row 3.

Row 8: Ch² (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each hdc and ch-1 sp across – 201 hdc.

Fasten off.

Repeat on opposite long side edge.

SIDE PANELS (make 2 – 1 with B and 1 with C)

Make same as Center Panel but do not work the edging.

FINISHING

Sew a Side Panel on each side of the Center Panel.

Side Border

From RS, join D with a sl st in any corner of Afghan so that you are ready to work along a long edge.

Repeat Rows 1-4 of Edging on Center Panel. Fasten off.


Work side border along opposite long side of Afghan.


Weave in ends.

hdc = half double crochet
rep = repeat
RS = right side
sc = single crochet
sk = skip
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitch(es)
tog = together
