

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Go For Faux Cheltenham Hat

Pattern Number: L80132



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

Finished Circumference About 19 in. (48.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Finished Height About 9 in. (23 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Go For Faux (Art. #322)
 - 204 Chinchilla 1 ball
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Double pointed knitting needles size 10.5 (6.5 mm), set of 5

<u>GAUGE</u>

10 1/2 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

<u>NOTES</u>

- 1. The Hat is knit in one piece in the round.
- 2. If you'd like to keep the yarn contained as you work, slip the ball into a zippered plastic bag. Zip the bag closed, leaving an opening for the strand of yarn.

HAT

Cast on 50 sts – with 12 sts on each of 2 needles and 13 sts on each of 2 needles.

Join by knitting the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle.

You'll be knitting in the round on double pointed needles, but unlike traditional knitting in the round, you do not need to place a marker for the beginning of the round.

Due to the nature of this yarn, you don't need to end exactly at the end of a round – this yarn is very stretchy and it won't show if you stop knitting at any point in a round.

Knit every round until you have about 2 yds. (2 m) of yarn remaining

Last Round: Knit 2 together around – you'll have 25 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle, then draw needle through remaining sts. Pull to gather top of Hat and knot securely.

FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends.
