**Lion Brand® Shawl in a Cake**  
**Easy Crochet Top**  
Pattern Number: L80191



## **SKILL LEVEL – Easy+**

### **SIZES**

S-L (1X-3X)

**Finished Width** About 23 (28) in. (58.5 (71) cm), including side edging

**Finished Length** About 18 (20) in. (45.5 (51) cm), after folding and seaming

**Note:** Pattern is written for smaller size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Shawl in a Cake (Art. #455)
  - 209 Jade Pool 2 (3) cakes
- Lion Brand® crochet hook F-5 (3.75 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

19 dc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

### **NOTES**

1. Top is made from 2 identical pieces: Front and Back.
2. Front and Back are both worked from side to side with shaping for neck.
3. Sides are joined at underarms and an edging is worked around the neck.

### **BACK**

Ch 87 (95).

#### **First Side**

**Row 1 (RS):** Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc) and in each ch across – you will have 85 (93) dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next st and in each dc across working last dc in top of beg ch.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 8 (10 1/2) in. (20.5 (26.5) cm) from beg, end with a RS row as the last row you work.

#### **Shape Neck**

**Row 1 (WS):** Turn, sl st in first 5 sts, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next st and in each dc across, working last dc in top of beg ch – 81 (89) dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next dc and in each dc across, working last dc in top of beg ch.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 15 (17 1/2) in. (38 (44.5) cm) from beg, end with a RS row as the last row you work.

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## Second Side

**Row 1 (WS):** Ch 6 (counts as 3 base ch and first dc), turn, dc in 4th ch from hook and in next 2 ch, dc in next dc and in each dc across, working last dc in top of beg ch – 85 (93) dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next dc and in each dc across, working last dc in top of beg ch.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 23 (28) in. (58.5 (71) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Fasten off.

## FRONT

Make same as Back.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulders.

Sew side edges together for about 1/2 in. (1.5 cm), about 10 (11) in. (25.5 (28) cm) below shoulder seam for armholes.

## Neck Edging

From RS, join yarn with sc at neck edge of one shoulder seam. Work sc evenly spaced around neck edge; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
