# <u>SKILL LEVEL</u> – Easy

<u>SIZE</u> About 30 x 30 in. (76 x 76 cm)

### MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Cupcake® (Art. #935)
  - 216 Spring Break 1 cake (A)
  - 210 Clown Car 1 cake (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size G-6 (4.25 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

## <u>GAUGE</u>

Five 3-dc groups + 9 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### NOTES

- 1. Afghan is made in one piece.
- 2. A First Triangle is worked first with increases and then with decreases.
- 3. A Second Triangle is worked along one edge of the First Triangle.
- 4. Refer to the diagram for Afghan construction.

# FIRST TRIANGLE

With A, ch 5.

**Row 1 (RS):** Work 3 dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in last ch – you will have 1 beg ch-sp, one 3-dc group and 1 final dc in this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 4, turn, 3 dc in sp between first 2 sts, sk the 3-dc group, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in sp between first 2 sts, 4 dc in beg ch-sp (counts as one 3-dc group and final dc in this row and all following rows) - 1 beg ch-sp, two 3-dc groups and 1 final dc.

**Row 4:** Ch 4, turn, 3 dc in sp between first 2 sts, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 5:** Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in sp between first 2 sts, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, 4 dc in beg ch-sp – 1 beg ch-sp, three 3-dc groups and 1 final dc.

**Row 6:** Ch 4, turn, 3 dc in sp between first 2 sts, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 7:** Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in sp between first 2 sts, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups, 4 dc in beg ch-sp – 1 beg ch-sp, four 3-dc groups and 1 final dc.

**Rows 8-51:** Rep Rows 6 and 7 until a total of 51 rows have been worked – you will have 1 beg ch-sp, twenty-six 3-dc groups and 1 final dc at the end of Row 51.

**Row 52:** Ch 4, turn, sk first 4 sts, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups, dc in top of beg ch - 1 beg ch-sp, twenty-five 3-dc groups and 1 final dc.



**Row 53:** Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in sp between first 2 sts, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups, dc in beg ch-sp.

**Rows 54-99:** Rep Rows 52 and 53 until there are a total of 99 rows – you will have 1 beg ch-sp, two 3-dc groups and 1 final dc at the end of Row 99.

**Row 100:** Ch 4, turn, sk first 4 sts, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, dc in top of beg ch – 1 beg ch-sp, one 3-dc group and 1 final dc.

Row 101: Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in sp between first 2 sts, dc in beg ch-sp.

Row 102: Ch 3, turn, sk the 3-dc group, dc in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.

#### SECOND TRIANGLE

From RS, join B with a sl st in ch at base of 3-dc group in Row 1.

**Row 1 (RS):** Working in ends of rows across long edge of First Triangle, ch 4, sk end of Row 1, 3 dc in end of next row, \*sk end of next row, 3 dc in end of next row; rep from \* across working last 3 dc in end of Row 102, dc in top of beg ch of Row 102 – you will have 1 beg ch-sp, fifty-one 3-dc groups and 1 final dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 4, turn, sk first 4 sts, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups, dc in beg ch-sp – 1 beg ch-sp, fifty 3-dc groups and 1 final dc.

**Rows 3-50:** Rep Row 2 until there are a total of 50 rows in Second Triangle – you will have 1 beg ch-sp, two 3-dc groups and 1 final dc at the end of Row 50.

**Row 51:** Ch 4, turn, sk first 4 sts, 3 dc in sp between 3-dc groups, dc in beg ch-sp – 1 beg ch-sp, one 3-dc group and 1 final dc.

**Row 52:** Ch 4, turn, sk the 3-dc group, dc in beg ch-sp. Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
