SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

About 42 x 61 in. (106.5 x 155 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Flikka (Art. #431)
 - 712 Keepsake 1 ball (A)
 - 710 Sidewalk 1 ball (B)
 - 707 Grape Jelly 1 ball (C)
 - 705 Dill Pickle 2 balls (D)
 - 708 Cloud Nine 2 balls (E)
 - 709 Wading Pool 2 balls (F)
 - 704 Library Book 1 ball (G)
 - 700 Birthday Cake 1 ball (H)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 8 (5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long or longer

GAUGE

1 ripple = about 7 in. (18 cm) measured from peak to peak.

24 rows = about 5 in. (18 cm) over Rows 1-24.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left hand needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right hand needle; insert left hand needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

1. The Afghan is knit in one piece with 8 colors of yarn.
2. Two versions of a ripple pattern are used in the Afghan – Garter St Ripple and Stockinette St Ripple.
3. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear
4. A circular needle is used to accommodate the number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle just as if working on straight needles.

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AFGHAN

With B, cast on 200 sts.

Garter st Ripple Pattern

Row 1 (RS): With B, k4, *kfb, k13, k2tog, ssk, k13, kfb; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 – 6 ripples.

Row 2 (WS): With B, knit.

Rows 3-8: Rep Rows 1 and 2 for 3 more times.

Stockinette st Ripple Pattern

Change to F.

Row 9 (RS): With F, k4, *kfb, k13, k2tog, ssk, k13, kfb; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4.

Row 10 (WS): With F, k4, p to last 4 sts, k4.

Rows 11-24: Rep Rows 9 and 10 for 7 more times.

Change to B.

Rows 25-32: With B, rep Rows 1-8.

Change to E.

Rows 33-38: With E, rep Rows 9 and 10 for 3 times.

Change to B.

Rows 39-52: Rep Rows 25-38.

Change to B.

Rows 53-60: With B, rep Rows 1-8.

Change to G.

Rows 61-76: With G, rep Rows 9-24.

Change to A.

Rep Rows 25-76 for 4 more times, changing yarn color as follows:
(8 rows with A, 6 rows with C) twice, 8 rows with A, 16 rows with H;
(8 rows with F, 6 rows with G) twice, 8 rows with F, 16 rows with D;
(8 rows with E, 6 rows with H) twice, 8 rows with E, 16 rows with C;
(8 rows with D, 6 rows with F) twice, 8 rows with D, 16 rows with E.

Change to D.

Last 8 Rows: With D, rep Rows 1-8.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
