## **SKILL LEVEL – Easy**

### **SIZE**

**Finished Circumference** About 76 in. (193 cm)

**Finished Height** About 5 in. (12.5 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Stitchbird (Art. #218)
  - 502 Purple Martin 2 cakes
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 11 (8 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

### **GAUGE**

12 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every st on every row).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### **STITCH EXPLANATION**

#### **kfb (knit into front and then back)**

An increase worked as follows:

1. Knit the next st through the front loop, but do not remove the st from your left hand needle.
2. Knit the same st once more, this time inserting your needle through the back loop of the st. You will have created 2 loops (sts) on your right hand needle.
3. Drop the st from your left hand needle – you have increased 1 st.

### **NOTES**

1. Cowl is worked in one piece, then sewn together to make a ring.
2. Increases and decreases are used to create a diagonal pattern.

### **COWL**

Cast on 3 sts.

Knit one row.

**Row 1:** K1, kfb, k to end of row – you will have 4 sts at the end of Row 1.

Repeat Row 1 until you have 35 sts.

**Next Row:** K1, kfb, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

**Next Row:** K1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Repeat last 2 rows until piece measures about 76 in. (193 cm) from beginning across the longest side.

**Next Row:** K1, k2tog, k to end of row – 34 sts.

Repeat last row until you have 3 sts.

Knit one row.

Bind off.

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## **FINISHING**

Sew short ends together to make the Cowl.

Weave in yarn ends.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

st(s) = stitch(es)
