

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Stitchbird Woodbine Cowl

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Lion Brand® Stitchbird **Woodbine Cowl** Pattern Number: L80175

SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

Finished Circumference About 76 in. (193 cm) Finished Height About 5 in. (12.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Stitchbird (Art. #218)
 - 502 Purple Martin 2 cakes
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 11 (8 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

12 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every st on every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

kfb (knit into front and then back)

An increase worked as follows:

- 1. Knit the next st through the front loop, but do not remove the st from your left hand needle.
- 2. Knit the same st once more, this time inserting your needle through the back loop of the st. You will have created 2 loops (sts) on your right hand needle.
- 3. Drop the st from your left hand needle you have increased 1 st.

NOTES

- 1. Cowl is worked in one piece, then sewn together to make a ring.
- 2. Increases and decreases are used to create a diagonal pattern.

COWL

Cast on 3 sts.

Knit one row.

Row 1: K1, kfb, k to end of row – you will have 4 sts at the end of Row 1.

Repeat Row 1 until you have 35 sts.

Next Row: K1, kfb, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. Next Row: K1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Repeat last 2 rows until piece measures about 76 in. (193 cm) from beginning

across the longest side.

Next Row: K1, k2tog, k to end of row – 34 sts.

Repeat last row until you have 3 sts.

Knit one row.

Bind off.

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FINISHING

Sew short ends together to make the Cowl.

Weave in yarn ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together
st(s) = stitch(es)
