### <u>SKILL LEVEL –</u> Easy+

## <u>SIZE</u>

About 9 x 11 in. (23 x 28 cm), after folding and seaming.

### MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Jeans® (Art. #505)
  - 105 Faded 1 ball (A)
    - 110 Classic 1 ball (B)
    - 121 Top Stitch 1 ball (C)
- Lion Brand® Jeans® Colors (Art. #506)
  - 123 Khaki 1 ball (D)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

# **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Snap closure Sewing needle and thread

## <u>GAUGE</u>

15 sc + 15 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## **STITCH EXPLANATIONS**

**sc2tog (sc 2 sts together)** (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased. **sc3tog (sc 3 sts together)** (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook – 2 sts decreased.

#### <u>NOTES</u>

- 1. Bag is worked in triangle and diamond shaped sections.
- 2. Follow the diagram for yarn colors and direction of work.
- 3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color.
- 4. Fringe is added to the Bag before folding and seaming.
- 5. A snap closure is sewn to the flap of the Bag.
- 6. A strap is crocheted separately, then sewn to Bag.





### BAG

#### Note

Refer to the diagram as you work to clarify yarn color and direction of work.

## Top Back Triangle

With C, ch 36.
Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 35 sc in this row.
Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each st to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 33 sc.
Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc3tog, sc in each st to last 3 sts, sc3tog – 29 sc.
Rows 4-11: Rep Rows 2 and 3 for 4 times – 5 sc in Row 11.
Row 12: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog – 3 sc.
Row 13: Ch 1, turn, sc3tog – 1 sc.
Fasten off.

**Edging:** From RS, draw up a loop of C in end of Row 1 so that you are ready to work up one of the diagonal edges, ch 1, work 22 sc evenly spaced along diagonal edge, work 3 sc in tip of triangle, work 22 sc evenly spaced along next diagonal edge, sl st in end of Row 1 - 47 sc. Fasten off.

## First Side Triangle

From RS, draw up a loop of B in the first st of edging.

**Row 1 (RS):** With B, ch 1, sc in same st as join, sc in next 13 sts; change to D, sc in next 9 sts – 23 sc (14 with B, 9 with D).

**Row 2:** With D, ch 1, turn, sc3tog, sc in each st to last D-colored st, 2 sc in last D-colored st; change to B, sc2tog, sc in each st to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 20 sc (12 with B, 8 with D).

**Row 3:** Working B-colored sts with B and D-colored sts with D, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 4:** With D, ch 1, turn, sc3tog, sc in each st to last D-colored st, 2 sc in last D-colored st; change to B, sc2tog, sc in each st to end of row – 18 sc (11 with B, 7 with D).

Row 5: Rep Row 3.

**Rows 6-13:** Rep Rows 2-5 twice – 8 sc (5 with B, 3 with D) in Row 12.

**Row 14:** With D, ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next st; change to B, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog – 5 sc (3 with B, 2 with D).

Row 15: Rep Row 3.

**Row 16:** With D, ch 1, turn, sc2tog; change to B, sc2tog, sc in last st – 3 sc (2 with B, 1 with D).

Row 17: Rep Row 3.

**Row 18:** With D, ch 1, turn, sc in first st; change to B, sc2tog – 2 sc (1 with B, 1 with D).

**Row 19:** With B, ch 1, turn, sc2tog - 1 sc.

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Fasten off.

## Second Side Triangle

From WS, draw up a loop of B in the last st of edging.

**Row 1 (WS):** With B, ch 1, sc in same st as join, sc in next 13 sts; change to D, sc in next 9 sts; leave next st (center st) of edging unworked – 23 sc (14 with B, 9 with D).

Rep Rows 2-19 of First Side Triangle. Fasten off.

## Center Back Diamond

From RS, draw up a loop of A in point of one side triangle so that you are ready to work along the D-colored diagonal edge.

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, work 20 sc evenly spaced along side edge of triangle, sc in unworked center edging st between triangles and place a marker in this st, work 20 sc evenly spaced along side edge of next triangle – 41 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to 3 sts before marked sc, sc3tog, sc in marked st and move marker to sc just made, sc3tog, sc in each st to end of row -37 sc. Continue to move marker up as work progresses.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each st to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 35 sc.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to 1 st before marked sc, sc3tog, sc in each st to end of row – 33 sc.

**Rows 5-18:** Rep Rows 3 and 4 for 7 more times – 5 sc in Row 18. Remove marker.

**Row 19:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog – 3 sc.

**Row 20:** Ch 1, turn, sc3tog – 1 sc.

Fasten off.

**Edging:** From RS, draw up a loop of A in one side point of diamond so that you are ready to work up one of the diagonal edges, ch 1, work 20 sc as evenly spaced as possible along diagonal edge, work 3 sc in tip of diamond, work 20 sc evenly spaced along next diagonal edge, sl st in side point – 43 sc. Fasten off.

## Third Side Triangle

**Note:** The third and fourth side triangles are worked sideways to the center diamond. SI sts are worked at the beg or end of each row to join the side triangle to the diamond.

From RS, draw up a loop of B in first st of edging.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 15, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 13 ch; sl st in 2nd st of edging – 14 sc.

**Row 2:** SI st in next st of edging, turn, sk the sl sts, sc2tog, sc in each st to end of row – 13 sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each st to end of row; sl st in next st of edging - 12 sc.

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**Row 4:** SI st in next st of edging, turn, sk the sl sts, sc2tog, sc in each st to end of row – 11 sc.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row; sl st in next st of edging.

**Rows 6 and 7:** Rep Rows 4 and 5 – 10 sc in Row 6.

**Rows 8-19:** Rep Rows 2-7 twice – 2 sc in Row 18.

**Row 20:** SI st in next st of edging, turn, sk the sI sts, sc2tog – 1 sc.

Row 21: Ch 1, turn, sl st in same edging st as last sl st made.

Fasten off.

#### Fourth Side Triangle

From RS, sk first unworked st of center back diamond edging following third side triangle, draw up a loop of B in next sc.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 2, sc in 2nd ch from hook; sl st in next st of edging – 1 sc.

**Row 2:** SI st in next st of edging, turn, sk the sl sts, 2 sc in next st -2 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across; sl st in next st of edging.

**Row 4:** SI st in next st of edging, turn, sk the sl sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each st across – 3 sc.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st across; sl st in next st of edging – 4 sc.

**Row 6:** Rep Row 4 – 5 sc.

Rows 7 and 8: Rep Rows 3 and 4 – 6 sc in Row 8.

**Rows 9-20:** Rep Rows 3-8 twice – 14 sc in Row 20. Fasten off.

#### Lower Back Triangle

From RS, draw up a loop of D in side tip of one of the previous triangles so that you are ready to work along the diagonal edge of the triangle.

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, work 21 sc evenly spaced along diagonal edge, work 1 sc in the diamond edging between the triangles, work 21 sc evenly spaced along diagonal edge of the next side triangle -43 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 20 sts, sc3tog, sc in next 14 sts; leave rem 6 sts unworked – 35 sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sc in next 28 sts; leave rem 6 sts unworked – 28 sc. **Row 4:** Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sc in next 12 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 8 sts; leave rem 5 sts unworked – 21 sc.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sc in next 15 sts; leave rem 5 sts unworked – 15 sc. **Row 6:** Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sc in next 9 sts; leave rem 5 sts unworked – 9 sc.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sc in next 3 sts; leave rem 5 sts unworked – 3 sc.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, sc in 5 unworked sts at end of Row 6, sc in 5 unworked sts at end of Row 4, sc in 6 unworked sts at end of Row 2 – 19 sc.

**Row 9:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 19 sts, sc in 5 unworked sts at end of Row 7, sc in 5 unworked sts at end of Row 5, sc in 6 unworked sts at end of Row 3 - 35 sts. Change to C. Cut D.

#### Front

#### Notes

Wind yarn C into 2 balls before beginning this section. Yarn color is changed in every row to form triangle pattern on front of Bag.

Rows 1-8: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across – 35 sts.

**Row 9 (WS):** With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 16 sts; change to B, sc in next 3 sts; change to 2nd ball of C, sc in last 16 sts.

**Row 10:** With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 14 sts, sc2tog; change to B, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; change to C, sc2tog, sc in last 14 sts.

**Row 11:** With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 13 sts, sc2tog; change to B, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; change to C, sc2tog, sc in last 13 sts.

**Row 12:** With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first 12 sts, sc2tog; change to B, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st; change to C, sc2tog, sc in last 12 sts.

**Row 13:** Working C-colored sts with C and B-colored sts with B, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 14:** With C, ch 1, turn, sc in each st to 2 sts before next B-colored st, sc2tog; change to B, 2 sc in next st, sc in each st to last B-colored st, 2 sc in last B-colored st; change to C, sc2tog, sc in each st to end of row.

**Rows 15-26:** Rep Rows 13 and 14 for 6 more times – 6 with C, 23 with B, 6 with C in Row 26.

Rows 27 and 28: Rep Row 13 twice.

Row 29: Rep Row 14.

**Rows 30-41:** Rep Rows 27-29 for 4 more times – 1 with C, 33 with B, 1 with C in Row 41.

Rows 42 and 43: Rep Row 13 twice and change to B in last st of Row 43.

Cut C.

**Row 44 (RS):** With B, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

#### Flap

From RS, draw up a loop of A in 8th ch of foundation ch. **Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, sc in same st as join and in next 20 sc – 21 sc. **Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each st to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 19 sc. **Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. **Rows 4-19:** Rep Rows 2 and 3 for 8 more times – 3 sc in Row 18. **Row 20:** Ch 1, turn, sc3tog. Fasten off.

### Edging

From RS, draw up a loop of A in same st as first st of Row 1, ch 1, work sc evenly spaced along outer edge of flap, sl st in same st as last st of Row 1. Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

#### Fringes

For each fringe, cut a 12 in. (30.5 cm) strand of D. Fold strand in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of Bag, making a loop.

Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten.

Make fringes along diagonal edges of front triangle and along color change line of first and second back side triangles. Trim fringe ends evenly.

From WS, fold piece in half and sew side seams. Turn Bag right side out. With sewing needle and thread, sew one half of snap closure to underside of flap. Sew other half of snap closure to front of Bag.

#### Strap

With C, chain 5. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each of next 3 ch - 4 sc. **Next Row:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across. Rep last row until Strap measures about 36 in. (95.5 cm). Fasten off.

With sewing needle and thread, sew ends of Strap to top edge of Bag.

Weave in ends.
