## **SKILL LEVEL – Easy**

### **SIZE**

About 50 x 66 in. (127 x 167.5 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Color Made Easy (Art. #195)
  - 106 Blue Moon 2 balls (A)
  - 149 Shade 2 balls (B)
  - 150 Basalt 2 balls (C)
  - 143 Prism 2 balls (D)
  - 147 Ultra Violet 2 balls (E)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size N (10 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

3 shells = about 4 1/4 in. (11 cm); 4 rows = about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm) in Pattern I.

9 dc = about 4 1/4 in. (11 cm) in Pattern II.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### **STITCH EXPLANATIONS**

**shell** Work 3 dc in indicated st or sp.

**V-st (V-stitch)** Work (dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st or sp.

### **PATTERN STITCHES**

#### **Pattern I (worked over a multiple of 3 sts + 2 additional sts)**

**Row 1 (RS):** Work shell in 6th ch from hook, \*sk next 2 ch, shell in next ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, sk next ch, dc in last ch.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, V-st in 2nd dc (center dc) of each shell across, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, shell in ch-1 sp of each V-st across, dc in top of beg ch-3.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 for Pattern I.

#### **Pattern II (worked over a multiple of 3 sts + 2 additional sts)**

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk first st, dc in each st across.

**Rows 2 and 3:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

**Row 4:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next st, \*ch 1, sk next st, dc in next 2 sts; rep from \* across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

**Rows 5 and 6:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next st, \*ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 dc; repeat from \* across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

**Row 7:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each dc and ch-1 sp across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

**Rows 8 and 9:** Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Rep Rows 4-9 for Pattern II.

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## **NOTES**

1. Afghan is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows.
2. Patterns I and II are alternated and 5 yarn colors are used.
3. To change yarn color, fasten off old color. With RS facing, join new color with sl st in top of beg ch-3 of row just completed.
4. For those who find visuals helpful, we've included stitch diagrams.

## **AFGHAN**

With A, ch 110.

**Row 1 (RS):** Work Row 1 of Pattern I – you will have 35 shells and 1 dc at beg and end of this row.

**Row 2:** Work Row 2 of Pattern I – 35 V-sts and 1 dc at beg and end of row.

**Rows 3-15:** Beg with Row 3 of pattern, work in Pattern I for 13 more rows. Fasten off.

With RS facing, join B with a sl st in top of beg ch-3 of Row 15.

**Row 16 (RS):** Work Row 1 of Pattern II – 107 dc.

**Rows 17-19:** Work Rows 2-4 of Pattern II – 72 dc and 35 ch-1 sps.

**Rows 20-30:** Beg with Row 5 of pattern, work in Pattern II for 11 more rows. Fasten off.

With RS facing, join C with a sl st in top of beg ch-3 of Row 30.

**Row 31 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk first 2 sts, shell in next st, \*sk next 2 sts, shell in next st; rep from \* to last 2 sts, sk next st, dc in next st.

**Rows 32-45:** Beg with Row 2 of pattern, work in Pattern I for 14 more rows. Fasten off.

With RS facing, join D with a sl st in top of beg ch-3 of Row 45.

**Rows 46-60:** Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Pattern II for 15 rows. Fasten off.

With RS facing, join E with a sl st in top of beg ch-3 of Row 60.

**Row 61 (RS):** Rep Row 31.

**Rows 62-75:** Beg with Row 2 of pattern, work in Pattern I for 14 more rows. Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

ch-sp(s) = space(s) previously made

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

RS = right side

sk = skip

sl st = slip stitch

sp = space

st(s) = stitch(es)

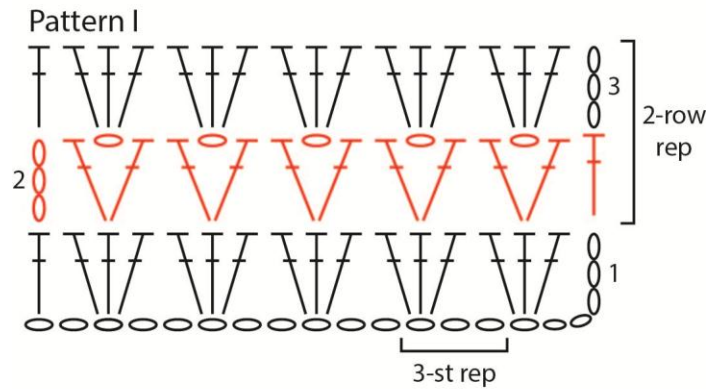
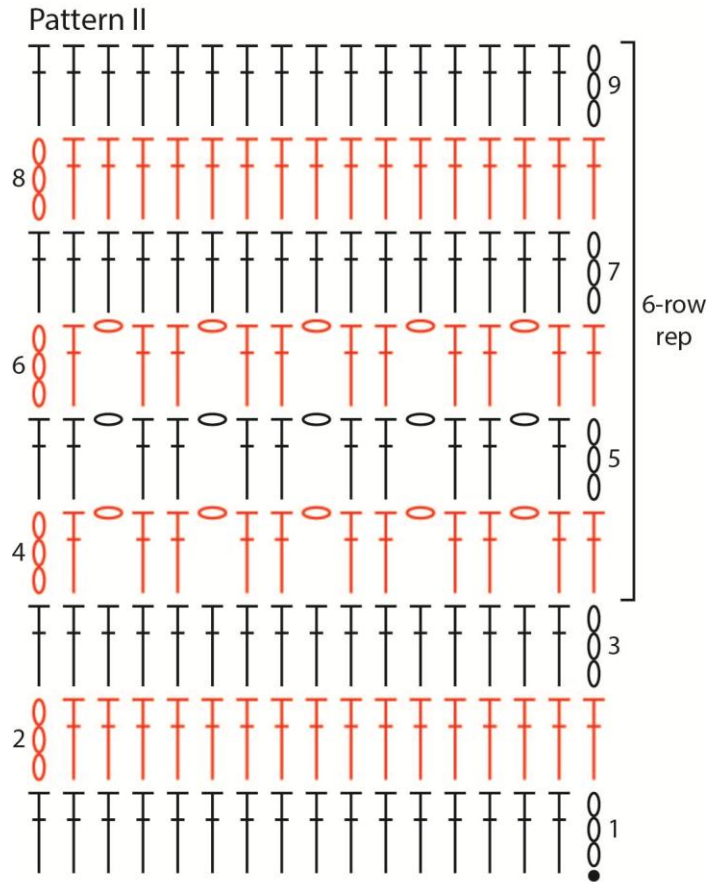
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**KEY**
