

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Color Made Easy Roscoe Scarf

Pattern Number: L80207 Designed by Irina Poludnenko



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<u>SKILL LEVEL –</u> Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

About 10 x 104 in. (25.5 x 264 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Color Made Easy (Art. #195)
 - 113 Anthurium 1 ball (Å)
 - 138 Pomegranate 1 ball (B)
 - 126 Kombucha 1 ball (C)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 11 (8 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



10 sts + 20 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every st on every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

sk2p Slip 1 as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over – 2 sts decreased.

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog – 1 st decreased.

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.

2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

<u>NOTES</u>

- 1. The Scarf is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows.
- 2. For neat edges, beginning with Row 2, the first st of each row is slipped and the last st is purled.
- 3. When the pattern tells you to slip a st, slip as if to knit or as if to purl, whichever look you prefer.

SCARF

With A, cast on 1 st.

Row 1: (K1, yo, k1) all in the same st – you will have 3 sts in this row.

Row 2: SI 1 (selvedge), k1, p1 (selvedge).

Row 3: SI 1, kfb, p1 – 4 sts.

Row 4: SI 1, k2, p1.

Row 5: SI 1, (kfb) twice, p1 – 6 sts.

Row 6: SI 1, k to last st, p1.

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Row 7: SI 1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, p1 – 8 sts. **Row 8:** SI 1, k to last st, p1. **Rows 9-40:** Rep Rows 7 and 8 for 16 times – 40 sts in Row 40.

Row 41: SI 1, kfb, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, p1. Row 42: SI 1, k to last st, p1. Rows 43-72: Rep Rows 41 and 42 for 15 more times.

Rows 73 and 74: With B, rep Rows 41 and 42. Rows 75 and 76: With A, rep Rows 41 and 42. Rows 77-124: Rep Rows 73-76 for 12 more times. Cut A.

Rows 125-182: With B, rep Rows 41 and 42 for 29 times.

Rows 183 and 184: With C, rep Rows 41 and 42. **Rows 185 and 186:** With B, rep Rows 41 and 42. **Rows 187-234:** Rep Rows 73-76 for 12 more times. Cut B.

Rows 235-304: With C, rep Rows 41 and 42 for 35 times.

Rows 305 and 306: With A, rep Rows 41 and 42. Rows 307 and 308: With C, rep Rows 41 and 42. Rows 309-348: Rep Rows 73-76 for 10 more times. Cut A.

Continue with C only.

Row 349: SI 1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, ssk, p1 – 38 sts. Row 350: SI 1, k to last st, p1. Rows 351-384: Rep Rows 349 and 350 for 17 more times – 4 sts in Row 384. Row 385: SI 1, k2tog, p1 – 3 sts. Row 386: Sk2p – 1 st. Fasten off last st.

<u>FINISHING</u>

Weave in ends.
