

Free Crochet Pattern **Lion Brand® Homespun® New Look** Striations Afghan Pattern Number: L80153



SKILL LEVEL - Beginner

SIZE

About 40 x 42 in. (101.5 x 106.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Homepun® New Look (Art. #575)
 - 603 Aubergine 1 cake (A)
 - 619 Misty Morning 1 cake (B)
 - 610 Foliage 1 cake (C)
 - 618 Circus 1 cake (D)
 - 613 Fireworks 1 cake (E)
 - 604 Bright Horizon 1 cake (F)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

11 dc + 7 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. The Afghan is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows, with 6 colors of yarn.
- 2. The yarn color is changed each time you finish an entire cake of one yarn color. You can change yarn color mid-row you don't need to wait until you begin a new row.
- To change yarn color, work last st with old color until 2 loops remain on hook. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete the st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
- 4. The chain 3 at the beginning of every row is a turning chain and does not count as a stitch.

AFGHAN

With A, chain 115.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across – you'll have 112 sts.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

With A, repeat Row 2 until almost all of yarn A has been used, changing to yarn B as you work the last st with A.

With B, repeat Row 2 until almost all of yarn B has been used, changing to yarn C in last st with B.

With C, repeat Row 2 until almost all of yarn C has been used, changing to yarn D in last st with C.

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With D, repeat Row 2 until almost all of yarn D has been used, changing to yarn E in last st with D.

With E, repeat Row 2 until almost all of yarn E has been used, changing to yarn F in last st with E.

With F, repeat Row 2 until you don't have enough of yarn F remaining to work another row.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
