SIZE

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® WOOL-EASE® THICK & QUICK® (Art. #640)
 - 099 Fisherman 1 ball
 - 123 Oatmeal 1 ball
 - 172 Kale 1 ball
 - 189 Butterscotch 1 ball
- LION BRAND® VANNA'S CHOICE® (Art. #860)
 - 098 Fisherman 1 ball
- LION BRAND® SCARFIE® (Art. #826)
 - 205 Cranberry/Black 1 ball
- LION BRAND® JEANS® (Art. #505)
 - 121 Top Stitch 1 ball
- LION BRAND® JEANS® COLORS (Art. # 506)
 - 101 Bermuda Shorts 1 ball

We've listed all the yarns and colors we used for these festive wrappings – but feel free to use any colors you like!

DIRECTIONS:

Cut strands of yarn, as many as you like, and wrap around gift packages.

Work in one or two directions, leave strands a bit messy or wrap them into even rows.

Now, add the fun embellishments!

Following package directions, make pom-poms and tie or glue to tops of packages.

Craft yarn bows by winding yarn around a piece of cardboard (or even your phone!). Slip the cardboard out of the yarn loops, then with a strand of yarn wrap the loops together at the center.

Glue the bows to the tops of packages.

Knitted yarn bows add a cozy DIY touch. Just cast on enough stitches to make a piece twice as long as you'd like your finished bow to be. Work in Garter stitch (knit every stitch on every row) until the piece is as wide as you'd like your bow to be.

Bind off and weave in ends.

Fold piece in half.

With a strand of yarn, wrap the center of the bow.

Glue the bows to the tops of packages.

Don't forget to add a touch of nature by sliding foraged leaves, branches or berries into the yarn wraps.
