Lion Brand® Ice Cream® Big Scoop®
Salida Hooded Popover
Pattern Number: L80308



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZES

2-3 years (4-6 years)

Finished Width About 20 (22) in. (51 (56) cm)

Finished Length About 13 (15 1/2) in. (33 (39.5) cm).

Note: Pattern is written for smaller size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Ice Cream® Big Scoop® (Art. #922)
 - 220 Parfait 1 (1) ball
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® stitch holders
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 4 (3.5 mm), 24 in. (61 cm) long

GAUGE

22 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Popover is worked in 2 pieces, the Front and the Back.
2. The hood is worked from stitches picked up around the neck edge of the Popover.
3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the number of sts. Work back and forth on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.
4. When you see 'work even' in the instructions, this means to continue on in the pattern st you have established without changing the st count by increasing, decreasing, or binding off.

BACK

Cast on 106 (120) sts.

Work in Garter st (k every st on every row), until piece measures about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from beginning.

Next Row (WS): Work in Garter st as established over first 14 sts, place marker (pm), p to last 14 sts, pm, work in Garter st to end of row.

Work even, keeping first and last 14 sts in Garter st, slipping markers as you come to them and working rem sts between markers in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures about 12 (13) in. (30.5 (33) cm) from beg, end with a WS (purl) row as the last row you work.

Shape neck

Next Row (RS): K to marker, slip marker (sm), knit 28 (33) and slip the last 42 (47) sts onto a st holder for right side; bind off next 22 (26) sts for back neck; k to end of row – 42 (47) sts.

Left Side

Left side is worked over 42 (47) sts on needle.

Row 1 (WS): K to marker, sm, p to end of row.

Row 2: Bind off 2 sts, k to marker, sm, k to end of row – 40 (45) sts.

Row 3: K to marker, sm, p to end of row.

Row 4: K2tog, k to marker, sm, k to end of row – 39 (44) sts.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 once more – 38 (43) sts.

Bind off.

Right Side

Place 42 (47) right side sts from holder back onto needle ready to work a WS row.

Row 1 (WS): Bind off 2 sts, p to marker, sm, k to end of row – 40 (45) sts.

Row 2: K to marker, sm, k to end of row.

Row 3: P2tog, p to marker, sm, k to end of row – 39 (44) sts.

Row 4: K to marker, sm, k to end of row.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 once more – 38 (43) sts.

Bind off

FRONT

Cast on and work same as for Back until piece measures about 8 (9) in. (20.5 (23) cm) from beg, end with a RS row as the last row you work.

Divide for Front Slit

Next Row (WS): K to marker, sm, p32 (39), pm, k14, pm, p to next marker, sm, k to end of row.

Next Row: K to first marker, sm, k to next marker, sm, k7; slip rem sts onto a st holder for right front.

Left Front

Left front is worked over 53 (60) sts on needle.

Next Row (WS): K to marker, sm, p to next marker, sm, k to end of row.

Next Row: Knit, slipping markers as you come to them.

Work even in pattern until piece measures about 11 (13 1/2) in. (28 (34.5) cm) from beg, end with a RS row as the last row you work.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (WS): K7, remove marker, p1 (3), slip these 8 (10) sts onto a st holder for front neck, p to marker, sm, k to end of row – 45 (50) sts.

Row 2: K to marker, sm, k to end of row.

Row 3: Bind off 2 sts, p to marker, sm, k to end of row – 43 (48) sts.

Row 4: K to marker, sm, k to end of row.

Row 5: P2tog, p to marker, sm, k to end of row – 42 (47) sts.

Rep Rows 4 and 5 for 4 more times – 38 (43) sts.

Work even in pattern until piece measures same length as Back.

Bind off.

Right Front

Place right front sts back onto needle ready to work a WS row.

Next Row (WS): K to marker, sm, p to next marker, sm, k to end of row.

Next Row: Knit.

Work even in pattern until piece measures about 11 (13 1/2) in. (28 (34.5) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (WS): K7, remove marker, k1 (3), slip these 8 (10) sts onto a st holder for front neck, k to marker, sm, k to end of row – 45 (50) sts.

Row 2: K to marker, sm, p to end of row.

Row 3: Bind off 2 sts, k to marker, sm, k to end of row – 43 (48) sts.

Row 4: K to marker, sm, p to end of row.

Row 5: K2tog, k to marker, sm, k to end of row – 42 (47) sts.

Rep Rows 4 and 5 for 4 more times – 38 (43) sts.

Work even in pattern until piece measures same length as Back.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

Hood

From RS and starting at center right front, k8 (10) right front sts from holder, pick up and k21 sts evenly spaced along right neck edge to back neck holder, k22 (26) back neck sts, pick up and k21 sts evenly spaced along left neck edge, k8 (10) left front sts from holder – you'll have 80 (88) sts.

Row 1 (WS): K7, pm, p to last 7 sts, pm, k to end of row.

Row 2: Knit, slipping markers as you come to them.

Row 3: K7, sm, p to last 7 sts, sm, k to end of row.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until hood measures about 8 1/2 (9) in. (21.5 (23) cm), end with WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Top of Hood

Next Row (RS): K40 (44); slip rem sts onto a st holder for left side.

Right Side

Right side of hood is worked over the 40 (44) sts on the needle.

Next Row (WS): Bind off 3 sts, p to marker, k to end of row – 37 (41) sts.

Next Row: Knit, slipping marker as you work.

Rep last 2 rows for 6 more times – 19 (23) sts.

Bind off.

Left Side

Slip left side sts back onto needle ready to work a RS row

Next Row (RS): Bind off 3 sts, k to end of row slipping marker as you work – 37 (41) sts.

(41) sts.

Next Row: K to marker, sm, p to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows for 6 more times – 19 (23) sts.

Bind off.

Sew top of hood.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

rem = remain(ing)(s)

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

tog = together

WS = wrong side
