# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand® Fishermen's Wool Speckled Shrug

**SKILL LEVEL**: Easy

SIZE: One Size

About 38 x 44 in. (96.5 x 112 cm), before folding and seaming

#### **MATERIALS**

- 150-200 Lion Brand Fishermen's Wool Yarn: Oak Tweed
   2 Balls
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- · Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Additional Materials
   Circular knitting needle size 9 (5.5 mm), 29 in. (73.5 cm) long

#### **GAUGE:**

16 sts + 22 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

#### **PATTERN STITCH**

K1, p1 Rib (odd number of sts)


Row 1: \*K1, p1; rep from \* to last st, k last st.

**Row 2:** K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for K1, p1 Rib.

# NOTES:

Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.



### **SHRUG**

Cast on 153 sts. Work in K1, p1 Rib until piece measures 2 in. (5 cm) from beg. Work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures 42 in. (106.5 cm) from beg. Work in K1, p1 Rib until piece measures 44 in. (112 cm) from beg. Bind off.

#### **FINISHING**

Fold piece in half, bringing cast-on edge to bound off edge, to measure  $38 \times 22$  in. (96.5 x 56 cm). Place markers on each of the 22 in. (56 cm) sides, 7 in. (18 cm) below fold for armholes. Seam sides from marker down to lower edge. Weave in ends.
