SKILL LEVEL – Intermediate

SIZE

About 20 x 65 in. (51 x 165 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Shawl In A Ball (Art. #828)
 - 214 Zen Azalea 4 ballsl
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

1 Strip = about 1 1/4 in. (3 cm) wide; 9 rows = about 5 in. (12.5 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Shell (7 dc, ch 3, sl st) all in indicated ch-sp.

NOTES

- 1. Shawl is worked in one piece in Strips of shells.
- 2. Each Strip is worked back and forth in rows. Each row consists of a single shell.
- 3. As each Strip is worked, it is joined to the previous Strip, leaving the first and last 4-6 in. (10-15 cm) unjoined to create fringe.
- 4. For those who find visuals helpful, we've included stitch and assembly diagrams.

STRIP I

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to make a ring.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3, (7 dc, ch 3, sl st) in ring (shell made).

Rows 2-117: Ch 3, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row – you'll have 1 shell in each row.

Fasten off.

STRIP II

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to make a ring.

Beginning Fringe

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3, (7 dc, ch 3, sl st) in ring (shell made).

Rows 2-11: Ch 3, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row.

Join to Previous Strip

Lay Strip I lengthwise onto a flat surface with RS facing and odd-numbered rows along top of Strip.

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Counting shells along top edge only, place a stitch marker in ch-3 sp at beg of 8th shell.

Row 12: Ch 3, sl st in marked ch-3 sp of Strip I, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row of Strip II.

Row 13: Ch 3, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row.

Row 14: Ch 3, sl st in next ch-3 sp along top edge of Strip I, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row of Strip II.

Rep Rows 13 and 14 to last 7 shells along top edge of Strip I.

Ending Fringe

Next 11 Rows: Ch 3, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row. Fasten off.

STRIP III

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to make a ring.

Beginning Fringe

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3, (7 dc, ch 3, sl st) in ring (shell made).

Rows 2-13: Ch 3, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row.

Join to Previous Strip

Lay previous Strips lengthwise onto a flat surface with RS facing and oddnumbered rows of Strip II along top.

Counting shells along top edge only, place a stitch marker in ch-3 sp at beg of 6th shell.

Row 14: Ch 3, sl st in marked ch-3 sp of Strip II, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row of Strip III.

Row 15: Ch 3, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row.

Row 16: Ch 3, sl st in next ch-3 sp along edge of Strip II, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row of Strip III.

Rep Rows 15 and 16 to last 5 shells along top edge of Strip II.

Ending Fringe

Next 13 Rows: Ch 3, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row. Fasten off.

STRIP IV

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to make a ring.

Beginning Fringe

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3, (7 dc, ch 3, sl st) in ring (shell made).

Rows 2-13: Ch 3, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row.

Join to Previous Strip

Lay previous Strips lengthwise onto a flat surface with RS facing and oddnumbered rows of Strip III along top.

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Counting shells along top edge only, place a stitch marker in ch-3 sp at beg of 7th shell.

Row 14: Ch 3, sl st in first marked ch-3 sp of Strip III, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row of Strip IV.

Row 15: Ch 3, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row.

Row 16: Ch 3, sl st in next ch-3 sp along edge of Strip III, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row of Strip IV.

Rep Rows 15 and 16 to last 6 shells along top edge of Strip III.

Ending Fringe

Next 13 Rows: Ch 3, turn, shell in ch-3 sp at end of previous row. Fasten off.

Rep Strips II-IV for 4 more times, then rep Strip II once more, joining each new Strip to previous Strips.

FINISHING


Weave in ends.


beg = begin(ning)

RS = right side
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitch(es)




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KEY
