

Free Crochet Pattern **Lion Brand® Hometown USA®** Kittery Cowl Pattern Number: L80333

SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

Finished Circumference About 28 in. (71 cm)
Finished Height About 10 in. (25.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Hometown USA® (Art. #135)
 - 224 Milwaukee Midnight 2 balls
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size N (10 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

7 dc = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

CI (3 double crochet cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), (yarn over, insert hook in *same* st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice; yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

NOTE

Cowl is crocheted in one piece, back and forth in rows, and then seamed.

COWL

Ch 20.

Set-up Row (RS): Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc), dc in next 10 ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch) twice, dc in last 2 ch – you will have 16 dc and 2 ch-1 sps.

Row 1: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 dc, (Cl in next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc) twice, sc in each dc to beg ch, sc in top of beg ch-3 – 16 sc and 2 Cl.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first sc, dc in next 11 sc, (ch 1, sk next Cl, dc in next sc) twice, dc in last 2 sc.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 28 in. (68.5 cm) from beg, end with a Row 1 as the last row you work. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew ends of piece together to make a ring.

Weave in ends.

sc = single crochet
sk = skip
st(s) = stitch(es)
