

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Shawl In A Cake Sula Shawl

SKILL LEVEL – Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

About 37 x 68 in. (94 x 172.5 cm) at longest and widest points

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Shawl In A Cake (Art. #455)
 - 300 Om Opal 2 cakes
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

7 (dc, ch 1) groups = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.



STITCH EXPLANATIONS

CI (2 double crochet cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook), yarn over, insert hook in *same* st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

CI-V (cluster V-stitch) Work (CI, ch 1, CI) in indicated st or sp.

Center CI-V (center cluster V-stitch) Work (CI, ch 3, CI) in indicated st or sp.

NOTES

- 1. Shawl is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows, in an easy pattern, beginning at center back neck.
- 2. Chain fringe is added to the shaped edges of the Shawl.
- 3. For those who find a visual helpful, we have provided a stitch diagram.

SHAWL

Ch 6.

Row 1: (Tr, ch 3, tr, ch 1, tr) in 6th ch from hook (5 skipped ch count as tr, ch 1) – you will have 4 tr, 2 ch-1 sps, and a center ch-3 sp.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 in this row and in all following rows), turn, sk first ch-1 sp, Cl-V in next st, ch 1, Center Cl-V in center ch-3 sp, ch 1, Cl-V in next st, ch 1, dc in 5th ch of beg ch – 1 Center Cl-V, 2 Cl-V, 4 ch-1 sps and a dc at beg and end of this row.

Row 3: Ch 4, turn, sk first ch-1 sp, Cl-V in ch-1 sp of first Cl-V, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, Center Cl-V in center ch-3 sp, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, Cl-V in ch-1 sp of next Cl-V, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 1 Center Cl-V, 2 Cl-V, 6 ch-1 sps, and 4 dc.

Row 4: Ch 4, turn, sk first ch-1 sp, Cl-V in ch-1 sp of first Cl-V, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, Center Cl-V in center ch-3 sp, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, Cl-V in ch-1 sp of next Cl-V, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 1 Center Cl-V, 2 Cl-V, 10 ch-1 sps, and 8 dc.

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Row 5: Ch 4, turn, sk first ch-1 sp, Cl-V in ch-1 sp of first Cl-V, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, (ch 1, dc in next dc) to ch-1 sp before Center Cl-V, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, Center Cl-V in center ch-3 sp, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, (ch 1, dc in next dc) to ch-1 sp before next Cl-V, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, Cl-V in ch-1 sp of next Cl-V, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 1 Center Cl-V, 2 Cl-V, 14 ch-1 sps, and 12 dc.

Rows 6-49: Repeat Row 5 for 44 more times – 1 Center Cl-V, 2 Cl-V, 190 ch-1 sps and 188 dc in Row 49.

At the end of Row 49, do NOT fasten off.

Edging

Work chain fringe edging along both shaped edges of Shawl as follows:

Slip st into edge of Shawl, ch 20 for chain fringe, do not turn, move a short distance along shaped edge of Shawl and join end of chain with a slip st in edge of Shawl.

Repeat to make chain fringe along both shaped edges of Shawl, making 3 chain fringes all in same space at tip of Shawl.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends.

sp = space

st(s) = stitch(es)

tr = treble (triple) crochet
