

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Touch of Merino Traynor Shawl Pattern Number: L80337

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<u>SKILL LEVEL</u> – Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

About 20 x 67 1/2 in. (51 x 171.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Touch of Merino (Art. #676)
 - 172 lvy 2 balls (A)
 - 153 Black 1 ball (B)
 - 098 Gardenia 1 ball (C)
 - 113 Beet Red 1 ball (D)
 - 133 Amberglow 1 ball (E)
 - 150 Oxford Grey 1 ball (F)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 5 (3.75 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

<u>GAUGE</u>

22 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Pattern sts. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Make Star Knit next 3 sts together but do not remove sts from left needle, yarn over (take yarn from back to front over right needle then between needles to back), knit the same 3 sts together and remove sts from left needle.

PATTERN STITCHES

Pattern I (worked over a multiple of 6 sts + 2 additional sts)

Row 1 (RS): K1 (selvedge), *Make Star, k3; rep from * to last st, k1 (selvedge).
Row 2: Knit.
Row 3: K1, *k3, Make Star; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 4: Knit.

Rep Rows 1-4 for Pattern I.

Pattern II (worked over a multiple of 6 sts + 2 additional sts)

Rows 1-4: With first yarn color, knit.

Row 5 (RS): With second yarn color, k1 (selvedge), *sl 1 wyib, k4, sl 1 wyib; rep from * to last st, k1 (selvedge).

Row 6: With second yarn color, k1, *sl 1 wyif, p4, sl 1 wyif; rep from * to last st, k1.

Rep Rows 1-6 for Pattern II.

Pattern III

Rows 1 and 2: With first yarn color, knit.

Rows 3 and 4: With second yarn color, knit.

Rows 5 and 6: With third yarn color, knit.

Rep Rows 1-6 for Pattern III.

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Pattern IV (worked over a multiple of 4 sts + 2 additional sts)

Rows 1-4: With first yarn color, knit.

Row 5 (RS): With second yarn color, k1 (selvedge), *k2, sl 2 wyib; rep from * to last st, k1 (selvedge).

Row 6: With second yarn color, k1, *sl 2 wyif, p2; rep from * to last st, k1. Rep Rows 1-6 for Pattern IV.

Pattern V (worked over a multiple of 6 sts + 2 additional sts)

Rows 1-6: With first yarn color, knit.

Row 7 (RS): With second yarn color, k1 (selvedge), *k3, sl 3 wyib; rep from * to last st, k1 (selvedge).

Row 8: With second yarn color, k1, *sl 3 wyif, p3; rep from * to last st, k1.

Rows 9-12: With second yarn color, knit.

Rows 13 and 14: With third yarn color, rep Rows 7 and 8.

Rows 15-18: With third yarn color, knit.

Rep Rows 1-18 for Pattern V.

<u>NOTES</u>

- 1. Shawl is worked in one piece in sections that use different yarn colors and pattern sts.
- 2. To make neat edges, the first st and last st of every row are knit for selvedge sts.
- 3. When the pattern tells you to slip a st, slip as if to purl.
- 4. With yarn in front (wyif) refers to the side of the work facing you as you work the row; with yarn in back (wyib) refers to the side of the work that is away from you as you work the row. To move yarn from front to back or back to front, bring yarn between needles. Take care not to wrap yarn over a needle, this could create an additional st.
- 5. The pattern sts can be worked by following the written instructions or reading the charts. Read RS rows of charts from right to left and WS rows from left to right.

SHAWL

With A, cast on 110 sts.

With A, work in Pattern I until piece measures about 6 in. (15 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Using B for first yarn color and C for second yarn color, work in Pattern II for about 4 in. (10 cm), end with a Row 4 of pattern as the last row you work.

Using D as first yarn color, E as second yarn color, and F as third yarn color, work in Pattern III for about 3 in. (7.5 cm), end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Using A as first yarn color and B as second yarn color, work in Pattern IV for about 7 in. (18 cm), end with a Row 4 of pattern as the last row you work.

Using E as first yarn color, D as second yarn color, and C as third yarn color, work in Pattern V for about 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm), end with a WS row as the last row you work.

With F, work in Pattern I until piece measures about 6 in. (15 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Using A for first yarn color and E for second yarn color, work in Pattern II for about 4 in. (10 cm), end with a Row 4 of pattern as the last row you work.

Using B as first yarn color, D as second yarn color, and C as third yarn color, work in Pattern III for about 3 in. (7.5 cm), end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Using A as first yarn color and F as second yarn color, work in Pattern IV for about 7 in. (18 cm), end with a Row 4 of pattern as the last row you work.

Using B as first yarn color, C as second yarn color, and E as third yarn color, work in Pattern V for about 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm), end with a WS row as the last row you work.

With D, work in Pattern I until piece measures about 6 in. (15 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Using E for first yarn color and B for second yarn color, work in Pattern II for about 4 in. (10 cm), end with a Row 4 of pattern as the last row you work.

Using A as first yarn color, F as second yarn color, and C as third yarn color, work in Pattern III for about 3 in. (7.5 cm), end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Using B as first yarn color and D as second yarn color, work in Pattern IV for about 7 in. (18 cm), end with a Row 4 of pattern as the last row you work.

Using A as first yarn color, B as second yarn color, and F as third yarn color, work in Pattern V for about 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm), end with a WS row as the last row you work.


FINISHING

Weave in ends.

beg = begin(ning) k = knit p = purl rep = repeat RS = right side sl = slip st(s) = stitch(es) WS = wrong side wyib = with yarn in backwyif = with yarn in front
