SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZES

1 year (2-3 years, 4 years)

Finished Chest About 22 (24, 26) in. (56 (61, 66) cm)

Finished Length About 11 1/2 (12, 13 1/2) in. (29 (30.5, 34.5) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Terryspun (Art. #938)
 - 607 Fruit Punch 1 (1, 2) ball(s)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

12 dc = about 4 in. (10 cm); 12 rows = about 5 in. (12.5 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Cardigan is worked in one piece beginning at lower edge.
2. The stitches are worked in the spaces between stitches, not in the tops of stitches.
3. At armholes, the piece is divided and fronts and back are worked separately.
4. The Sleeves are crocheted separately and sewn to the Cardigan.

CARDIGAN

Ch 69 (75, 81).

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch do not count as a st) and in each ch across – you will have 66 (72, 78) dc in this row.

Rows 2-15 (15, 17): Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in each sp between sts across, working last dc in sp between last dc and beg ch-3.

Divide for Fronts and Back

Left Front

Row 1 (WS): Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in first 17 (19, 21) sps between sts; leave rem sps unworked for back and right front – 17 (19, 21) dc.

Rows 2-8 (10, 12): Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in each sp between sts across, working last dc in sp between last dc and beg ch-3.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (WS): Turn, sl st in first 9 (10, 11) sps between sts, ch 3 (does not count as a st), dc in each sp between sts across, working last dc in sp between last dc and beg ch-3 – 8 (9, 10) dc.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in each sp between sts across, working last dc in sp between last dc and beg ch-3.
Fasten off.

Back

From WS, join yarn with a sl st in same sp as last st of Row 1 of left front.

Row 1 (WS): Ch 3 (does not count as a st), dc in next 32 (34, 36) sps between sts; leave rem sts unworked for right front – 32 (34, 36) dc.

Rows 2-11 (13, 15): Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in each sp between sts across, working last dc in sp between last dc and beg ch-3.
Fasten off.

Right Front

From WS, join yarn with a sl st in same sp as last st of Row 1 of back.

Row 1 (WS): Ch 3 (does not count as a st), dc in each sp between sts across, working last dc in sp between last dc and beg ch-3 – 17 (19, 21) dc.

Rows 2-8 (10, 12): Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in each sp between sts across, working last dc in sp between last dc and beg ch-3.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (WS): Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in first 8 (9, 10) sps between sts; leave rem sps unworked – 8 (9, 10) dc.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in each sp between sts across, working last dc in sp between last dc and beg ch-3.
Fasten off.

SLEEVES (make 2)

Ch 19 (21, 23).

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch do not count as a st) and in each ch across – 16 (18, 20) dc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in each sp between sts across working last dc in sp between last dc and beg ch-3.

Row 3 (Increase Row): Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, 2 dc in first sp between sts (increase made), dc in each sp between sts to last sp, 2 dc in sp between last dc and beg ch-3 – 18 (20, 22) dc.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 for 6 (7, 8) more times – 30 (34, 38) dc when all increases have been worked, then rep Row 2 twice more.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew Sleeve seams, then sew Sleeves into armholes.

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Edging

From RS, join yarn with a sl st anywhere along outside edge of Cardigan.

Ch 1, work sc evenly spaced around entire outer edge of Cardigan, working 2 sc in each corner; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
