

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Re-Up® Lucy Apron Pattern Number: L90053

SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

Finished Length About 15 in. (38 cm) Finished Width About 18 in. (45.5 cm)

Apron is one size to fit most adults. Waist ties are adjustable.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Re-Up® (Art. #834)
 - 098 Ecru 2 balls (A)
 - 102 Aqua 1 ball (B)
- Lion Brand® stitch holders
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 8 (5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

GAUGE

18 sts + 30 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Slip St pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. The Apron is worked in one piece in an easy 2 color Slip St pattern
- 2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.
- 3. The waistband and ties are worked directly across the top edge of the Apron, the pocket is worked separately and then sewn to the Apron.
- 4. The Slip St pattern can be worked by following our written instructions or the chart. When working from the chart, read RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right.
- 5. With yarn in front (wyif) refers to the side of the work facing you as you work the row. To move yarn from front to back or back to front, bring yarn between needles. Take care not to wrap yarn over a needle, this could create an additional st.

APRON

With A, cast on 76 sts. Knit 3 rows for lower edge border.

2 Color Slip St pattern

Note: There is no need to cut yarn between color changes, just carry the color not in use along the side edge of piece.

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Row 1 (WS): With A, k2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2: With A, k3, *sl 1 wyif, k1; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 3: With A, k2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 4: With A, k3, *k1, sl 1 wyif; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Rows 5-8: Rep Rows 1-4.

Rows 9 and 10: With B, rep Rows 1 and 2.

Rows 11 and 12: With A, rep Rows 3 and 4.

Rows 13 and 14: With B, rep Rows 1 and 2.

Rows 15 and 16: With A, rep Rows 3 and 4.

Rows 17 and 18: With A, rep Rows 1 and 2.

Rows 19 and 20: With B, rep Rows 3 and 4.

Rows 21 and 22: With A, rep Rows 1 and 2.

Rows 23-30: Rep Rows 19-22 twice.

Rows 31 and 32: With B, rep Rows 3 and 4.

Cut B and continue with A only.

Row 1 (WS): K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2: K3, *sl 1 wyif, k1; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 3: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 4: K3, *k1, sl 1 wyif; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Repeat last 4 rows until piece measures about 15 in. (38 cm) from beg, end with a Row 2 or 4 as the last row you work.

Leave sts on a spare needle or st holder.

Waistband and Ties

With A, cast on 93 sts for first tie; from WS, p76 apron sts from holder; then cast on 93 more sts for second tie – you will have 262 sts on needle. Knit 10 rows.

Bind off.

POCKET

With A, cast on 24 sts.

Rep Rows 1-32 of Apron.

Cut B and continue with A only.

Row 1 (WS): K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2: K3, *sl 1 wyif, k1; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 3: K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 4: K3, *k1, sl 1 wyif; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Rows 5-8: Rep Rows 1-4.

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Knit 3 rows. Bind off.

FINISHING

Pin Pocket to top right side of Apron, about 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) in from side edge and about 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) below waistband. Sew pocket to Apron.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side

wyif = with yarn in front
