

# Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Re-Up® Multi Cluster Dish Towel

# **SKILL LEVEL** – Easy

### SIZE

About 11 x 18 in. (28 x 45.5 cm)

# **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Re-Up® (Art. #834)
  - 100 White 2 balls (A)
  - 133 Orange 1 ball (B)
  - 112 Raspberry 1 ball (C)
  - 158 Sunflower 1 ball (D)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



# **GAUGE**

13 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in (sc, dc) pattern of Sc/Dc sections. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### STITCH EXPLANATION

**CI (5 double crochet cluster)** Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), (yarn over, insert hook in *same* st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 4 times (6 loops rem on hook), yarn over, draw through all loops on hook, ch 1 to close cluster. **Note:** The closing ch-1 does not count as a separate st. When working into a CI in following row, work into the closing ch.

### NOTE

- 1. Dish Towel is worked, back and forth in rows, in 3 sections.
- 2. The first and last section are worked in a pattern of alternating sc and dc sts. The center section is worked in a pattern of alternating sc and cluster sts
- 3. The yarn color is changed between sections and within the cluster section to form stripes.
- 4. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
- 5. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

### **DISH TOWEL**

With A. ch 37.

### Sc/Dc Section

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, \*sc in next ch, dc in next ch; rep from \* across – you will have 36 sts in this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* across.

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Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) from beg. Change to B in last st of last row worked.

### **Cluster Section**

Row 1 (Cluster Row): With B, ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, \*Cl in next sc, sc in next dc; rep from \* to last sc, dc in last sc and change to A - 19 sc and 17 clusters.

**Row 2:** With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next Cl, dc in next sc; rep from \* across and change to C in last st.

Row 3: With C, rep Row 1 and change to A in last st.

Row 4: With A, rep Row 2 and change to D in last st.

Row 5: With D, rep Row 1 and change to A in last st.

### Sc/Dc Section

**Row 1:** With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next Cl, dc in next sc; rep from \* across, do not change yarn color.

**Row 2:** With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* across.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 18 in. (45.5 cm) from beg. Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

beg = begin(ning)(s)
ch = chain
dc = double crochet
rep = repeat
sc = single crochet
st(s) = stitch(es)
