

# Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Beautiful You Short Sleeve Foldover Flyaway

## SKILL LEVEL – Easy

## <u>SIZES</u>

S/M (L, 1X/2X, 3X/4X)

**Finished Bust** About 48 (55, 59, 67) in. (122 (139.5, 150, 170) cm) **Finished Length** About 31 1/2 (32, 32 1/2, 33 1/2) in. (80 (81.5, 82.5, 85) cm) **Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

## MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Beautiful You (Art. #165)
- 184 Spanish Villa 6 (7, 8, 9) balls
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 4 (3.5 cm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



## <u>GAUGE</u>

25 1/2 sts + 36 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## **STITCH EXPLANATIONS**

**LLI (Lifted Left Increase)** With yarn held in back, insert right needle from back to front into st below next st on left needle, lift the st onto the left needle and knit the st.

**LRI (Lifted Right Increase)** With yarn held in back, insert left needle from back to front into st 2 rows below last st on right needle and knit the st.

## **NOTES**

- 1. Flyaway is worked in 3 pieces: Back and 2 Fronts.
- 2. Each piece is worked back and forth in rows beginning at lower edge.
- 3. The collar is worked in one piece with each Front.
- 4. When you see 'work in pattern as established' in the instructions, this means to work the next row of the pattern, lining up sts as in previous rows.
- 5. When you see work 'even' in the instructions, this means to continue on in the pattern st you have established without changing the st count by increasing, decreasing, or binding off.

## BACK

Cast on 153 (177, 189, 213) sts.

P3, k3 Rib Row 1 (WS): P3, \*k3, p3; rep from \* to end of row. Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts. Working loosely, rep Row 2 until piece measures about 4 in. (10 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Beg with a RS (knit) row, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measure about 20 in. (51 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

#### Shape Armholes

**Row 1 (Increase Row – RS):** K3, p3, k1, LRI, k to last 7 sts, LLI, k1, p3, k3 – you will have 155 (179, 191, 215) sts in this row.

**Rows 2-8:** Work in P3, k3 Rib as established over first 6 sts, work in St st to last 6 sts, work in P3, k3 Rib as established to end of row.

**Row 9:** Rep Row 1 – 157 (181, 193, 217) sts.

**Rows 10-81:** Rep Rows 2-9 for 9 more times – 175 (199, 211, 235) sts in Row 81. **Next 3 (7, 13, 21) Rows:** Work in P3, k3 Rib as established over first 6 sts, work in St st to last 6 sts, work in P3, k3 Rib as established to end of row.

#### Shape Shoulders

**Rows 1-16 (16, 14, 14):** Bind off 7 (8, 9, 10) sts, work in St st to end of row – 63 (71, 85, 95) sts in Row 16 (16, 14, 14).

**Next 2 (2, 4, 4) Rows:** Bind off 3 (3, 4, 5) sts, work in St st to end of row – 57 (65, 69, 75) sts when all bind offs have been completed.. Bind off rem sts.

#### LEFT FRONT

Cast on 102 (114, 126, 144) sts.

#### P3, k3 Rib

Row 1 (WS): \*P3, k3; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Working loosely, rep Row 2 until piece measures about 4 in. (10 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

**Next Row (RS):** K to last 55 (61, 67, 76) sts, place marker (pm), work in P3, k3 Rib as established to end of row for ribbed shawl collar.

**Next Row:** Work in P3, k3 Rib as established to marker, slip marker (sm), p to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures about 20 in. (51 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

#### Shape Armhole

**Row 1 (Increase Row – RS):** K3, p3, pm, k1, LRI, k to next marker, sm, work in P3, k3 Rib as established to end of row –103 (115, 127, 145) sts.

**Rows 2-8:** Work in P3, k3 Rib as established to marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in P3, k3 Rib as established to end of row.

**Row 9:** Work in P3, k3 Rib as established to marker, sm, k1, LRI, k to next marker, sm, work in P3, k3 Rib as established to end of row – 104 (116, 128, 146) sts.

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**Rows 10-81:** Rep Rows 2-9 for 9 more times – 113 (125, 137, 155) sts in Row 81. **Next 3 (7, 13, 21) Rows:** Work in P3, k3 Rib as established to marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in P3, k3 Rib as established to end of row.

#### Shape Shoulder

**Row 1 (RS):** Bind off 7 (8, 9, 10) sts and remove marker, work in patterns as established, slipping rem marker as you come to it -106 (117, 128, 145) sts. **Row 2:** Work in patterns as established, slipping marker as you come to it. **Rows 3-16 (16, 14, 14):** Rep Rows 1 and 2 for 7 (7, 6, 6) more times -57 (61, 74, 85) sts in Row 15 (15, 13, 13). **Note:** Remove rem marker when working last bind off. **Next Row:** Bind off 3 (3, 4, 5) sts, work in patterns as established to end of row -54 (60, 70, 80) sts.

**Next Row:** Work in patterns as established. Rep last 2 rows 0 (0, 1, 1) more time(s) - 54 (58, 66, 75) sts.

**Note:** When you see '0' repeats in an instruction, this means that you should not perform that particular instruction, just skip to the next instruction.

#### Collar Extension

Work even in P3, k3 Rib as established until collar extension measures about 4 1/2 (5, 5 1/2, 5 3/4) in. (11.5 (12.5, 14, 14.5) cm) Bind off loosely in rib.

## **RIGHT FRONT**

Cast on 102 (114, 126, 144) sts.

## P3, k3 Rib

Row 1 (WS): \*K3, p3; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Working loosely, rep Row 2 until piece measures about 4 in. (10 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

**Next Row (RS):** Work in P3, k3 Rib as established over first 55 (61, 67, 76) sts for ribbed shawl collar, pm, k to end of row.

**Next Row:** P to marker, sm, work in P3, k3 Rib as established to end of row. Rep last 2 rows until piece measures about 20 in. (51 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

#### Shape Armhole

**Row 1 (Increase Row – RS):** Work in P3, k3 Rib as established to marker, sm, k to last 7 sts, LLI, k1, pm, p3, k3 – 103 (115, 127, 145) sts in this row. **Rows 2-8:** Work in P3, k3 Rib as established to marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in P3, k3 Rib as established to end of row.

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**Rows 10-81:** Rep Rows 2-9 for 9 more times – 113 (125, 137, 155) sts in Row 81. **Next 3 (7, 13, 21) Rows:** Work in P3, k3 Rib as established to marker, sm, work in St st to next marker, sm, work in P3, k3 Rib as established to end of row.

## Shape Shoulder

Row 1 (RS): Work in patterns as established, slipping markers as you come to them.

**Row 2:** Bind off 7 (8, 9, 10) sts and remove marker, work in patterns as established, slipping rem marker as you come to it -106 (117, 128, 145) sts.

**Rows 3-16 (16, 14, 14):** Rep Rows 1 and 2 for 7 (7, 6, 6) more times – 57 (61, 74, 85) sts in Row 16 (16, 14, 14).

**Next Row:** Work in patterns as established, slipping rem marker as you come to it.

**Next Row:** Bind off 3 (3, 4, 5) sts, work in patterns as established to end of row – 54 (60, 70, 80) sts rem for collar extension.

Rep last 2 rows 0 (0, 1, 1) more time(s) – 54 (58, 66, 75) sts.

## **Collar Extension**

Work even in P3, k3 Rib as established until collar extension measures about 4 1/2 (5, 5 1/2, 5 3/4) in. (11.5 (12.5, 14, 14.5) cm) Bind off loosely in rib.

## **FINISHING**

## Blocking

Dampen pieces thoroughly. Spread a towel onto a flat surface, then lay pieces onto towel and smooth into shape. Gently shape to match finished measurements. Allow to air dry.

Sew shoulder seams.

Sew side seams.


Sew ends of collar extensions together, with seam on outside of Flyaway. Sew side edge of collar extensions to back neck, with seam on inside of Flyaway. Fold ribbed shawl collar in half.

Weave in ends.


