

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Feels Like Butta-Go For Faux Florence Flamingo

Pattern Number: L90086



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZES

About 8 in. (20.5 cm) tall

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Feels Like Butta (Art. #215)
 - #101 Pink 1 ball (A)
 - #100 White 1 ball (B)
 - #153 Black 1 ball (C)
 - #157 Yellow 1 ball (D)
- Lion Brand® Go For Faux (Art. #322)
 - #205 Pink Poodle 1 ball (E)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size F-5 (3.75 mm)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

- 2 safety eyes, 12mm diameter
- Fiberfill stuffing

GAUGE

24 sc + 28 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm) with smaller hook and A. EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT.

STITCH EXPLANATION

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

- 1. Flamingo is made in 9 pieces: Body/Neck/Head, 2 Eyes, 2 Feet, 2 Legs, and 2 Wings.
- 2. Pieces are stuffed and then sewn together to make the Flamingo.
- 3. Gauge is meant to be a bit tight this helps keep the stuffing from poking through.

FLAMINGO

BODY

Beg at back end of body, with smaller hook and A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 2, 4 and 6: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 3: Work 2 sc in each st around – you will have 12 sc in this rnd.

Rnd 5: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 7: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 8: *Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 9: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 10: *Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 11: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 12: *Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 36 sc.

Rnd 13: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 14: *Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 42 sc.

Rnd 15: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 16: *Sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 48 sc.

Rnd 17: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 18: *Sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 54 sc.

Rnd 19: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 20: *Sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 60 sc.

Rnds 21-47: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 48: *Sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 50 sc.

Rnd 49: *Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 40 sc.

Rnd 50: *Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Place a marker in Rnd 50 to indicate where sts will be sewn to shape bottom of neck.

Stuff body firmly.

Rnd 51: *Sc in next st, sc2tog; rep from * around – 20 sc.

NECK

Note

Stuff the neck firmly as your work progresses.

Rnds 52-63: Sc in each st around.

Place a marker in Rnd 63 to indicate where sts will be sewn to shape bottom of neck.

Rnds 64-87: Sc in each st around.

Place a marker in Rnd 87 to indicate where sts will be sewn to shape top of neck.

Rnds 88-93: Sc in each st around.

Bend neck up and sew marked Rnds 50 and 63 together with 3 sts to hold neck in place. Remove the markers from Rnds 50 and 63.

HEAD

Rnd 94: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 95: *Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 40 sc.

Rnd 96: Sc in each st around.

Place a marker in Rnd 96 to indicate where sts will be sewn to shape top of neck.

Rnds 97-106: Sc in each st around.

Bend top of neck down and sew marked Rnds 87 and 96 together with 3 sts to hold head in place. Remove markers from Rnds 87 and 96.

Rnd 107: *Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 32 sc.

Rnd 108: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 109: *Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 110: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 111: *Sc in next st, sc2tog; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc of this rnd – 16 sc.

Remove end of rnd marker.

Fasten off.

BEAK

Note

Read the beak instructions carefully before beginning. Some rnds are worked as continuous rnds (spiral) but others are worked as joined rnds.

Rnd 112: Join B with sl st in a st of Rnd 111 that is on the underside of the head, ch 1, sc in same st as joining sl st and in each sc around (take care not to work into the joining sl st of Rnd 111); join with sl st in first sc - 16 sc.

Rnd 113: Ch 1, sc in each st around; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral). Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 114: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 115: Sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc of this rnd.

Fasten off.

Remove end of rnd marker.

Rnd 116: Join A with sl st in a st of Rnd 115 that is on the underside of the beak, ch 1, sc in same st as joining sl st and in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc of this rnd.

Fasten off.

Rnd 117: Join C with sl st in a st of Rnd 116 that is on the underside of the beak, ch 1, sc in same st as joining sl st and in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc of this rnd.

Rnd 118: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Stuff head and beak firmly.

Rnd 119: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 12 sc.

Rnds 120 and 121: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 122: Ch 1, (sc2tog) 6 times; join with sl st in first sc - 6 sc.

Rnd 123: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

Stuff remainder of beak lightly, leaving last 3 rnds unstuffed.

Thread yarn tail onto blunt needle and sew Rnds 123 and 117 together to pull beak downward.

EYE (Make 2)

With smaller hook and B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc - 12 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

FOOT (Make 2)

Beg at heel, with smaller hook and D, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral). Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 2 and 3: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: Work 2 sc in each st around – 8 sc.

Rnd 5: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 12 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 7: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Do not fasten off, do not stuff.

FIRST TOE

Rnd 1: Sc in next 6 sts, leave remaining 12 sts unworked for second and third toes; join with sl st in first sc of this rnd – 6 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 3-7: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

Thread yarn tail onto blunt needle, weave through sts of last rnd and pull to close opening. Knot.

SECOND TOE

Rnd 1: Join D with sl st in first unworked st following first toe, ch 1, sc in same st as joining sl st and in next 2 unworked sts, sk next 6 unworked sts for third toe, sc in next 3 unworked sts; join with sl st in first sc of this rnd.

Rnds 2-7: Work same as Rnds 2-7 of first toe.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

Thread yarn tail onto blunt needle, weave through sts of last rnd and pull to close opening. Knot.

THIRD TOE

Rnd 1: Join D with sl st in first unworked st following second toe, ch 1, sc in same st as joining sl st and in next 5 unworked sts; join with sl st in first sc of this rnd.

Rnds 2-7: Work same as Rnds 2-7 of first toe.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

Thread yarn tail onto blunt needle, weave through sts of last rnd and pull to close opening. Knot.

LEG (Make 2)

With smaller hook and D, ch 11.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; join with sl st in first sc to begin working in rnds – 10 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 3-28: Sc in each st around.

KNEE

Rnd 29: Work 2 sc in each st around – 20 sc.

Rnds 30 and 31: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 32: (Sc2tog) 10 times – 10 sc.

Stuff knee only.

Rnds 33-60: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

Thread yarn tail onto blunt needle, weave through sts of last rnd and pull to close opening. Knot.

WING (Make 2)

With larger hook and E, ch 4.

Row 1: Work 2 dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc) – 3 dc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first st (increase made), dc in next st, 2 dc in top of beg ch-3 – 5 dc.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, dc in next st, dc in top of beg ch-3-6 dc.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first st, dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in top of beg ch-3 – 8 dc.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first st, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in top of beg ch-3 - 12 dc.

Row 6: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first st, dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in top of beg ch-3– 16 dc.

Row 7: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first dc, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Row 8: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, dc in next 12 sts, sk next st, dc in in top of beg ch-3 – 14 dc.

Row 9: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, dc in next 10 sts, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch-3 – 12 dc.

Row 10: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, dc in next 8 sts, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch-3 – 10 dc.

Row 11: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, dc in next 6 sts, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch-3-8 dc.

Row 12: Turn, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog (working over last dc and beg ch-3) – 6 sc.

Row 13: Turn, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog – 4 sc.

FINISHING

Following package directions, attach a safety eye to center of each Eye. Sew Eyes to Head above beak.

Sew legs to Flamingo.

Sew Wings to Body, lining up last row of Wing with the neck and overlapping the top edges of the Wings over the back of the Flamingo.

Leave the lower edge of each Wing unsewn so it moves freely.

Weave in ends.
