

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Stitchbird Basic Crochet Hat

Pattern Number: L80431 Designed by Sarah Zee



SKILL LEVEL - EASY

SIZE

Finished Circumference About 18 in. (45.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

MATERIALS

- •LION BRAND® STITCHBIRD (Art. #218) #503 Hummingbird 1 ball
- •LION BRAND® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- •LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



12 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm).
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.



sc2tog (single crochet 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTE

Ribbed band is worked back and forth in rows, then stitches for the Hat are picked up along the band and the Hat is worked in rounds.

HAT

Ribbed Band

Ch 9.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 8 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, working in front loops only, sc in each st across.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 18 in. (45.5 cm) from beg, unstretched.

Fold the band in half and work slip stitches through both thicknesses to connect band into a ring.

Do not fasten off.

Hat

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work 44 sc evenly spaced around Ribbed band; join with sl st in first sc.



Place marker for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in next st and in each st around.

Rnd 3: Hdc in each st around.

Rep Rnd 3 until piece measures about 8 in. (20.5 cm) from beg.

Shape Crown (top of Hat)

Rnd 1: *Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – you will have 33 sc.

Rnd 2: *Sc in next st, sc2tog; rep from * around – you will have 22 sc.

Rnd 3: Sc2tog around – 11 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and draw through remaining st.

Pull to gather and knot securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
