

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Feels Like Butta I Wanna Knit A Baby Blanket

Pattern Number: L90076



SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

About 30 x 30 in. (76 x 76 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Feels Like Butta (Art. #215)
 - #100 White 2 balls (A)
 - #101A Pink 2 balls (B)
 - #150D Charcoal 1 ball (C)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 5 (3.75 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

GAUGE

17 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every stitch on every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right hand needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES

- 1. The Blanket is worked in one piece on a circular needle.
- 2. The Blanket is worked diagonally, from corner to corner in 2 sections.
- 3. The first section increases the number of sts, the second section decreases the sts.
- 4. The circular needle is used to accommodate the number of stitches. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle, just as if working on straight needles.

BLANKET

With A, cast on 5 sts.

FIRST SECTION, INCREASE HALF OF BLANKET

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: K3, yo, k2 – you'll have 6 sts.

Row 3: K3, yo, k3 - 7 sts.

Row 4: K3, yo, k to end of row.

Repeat Row 4 until you have 50 sts on your needle.

Drop A, but do not cut the yarn.

With C, rep Row 4 twice.

Cut C.

With A, rep Row 4 until you have 70 sts.

Cut A.

With B, rep Row 4 until you have 88 sts.

Drop B, but do not cut the yarn.

With C, rep Row 4 twice.

Cut C.

With B, rep Row 4 until you have 132 sts.

Cut B.

With C, rep Row 4 twice.

Cut C.

With A, rep Row 4 until you have 176 sts.

Drop A, but do not cut the yarn.

With C, rep Row 4 twice.

Cut C.

With A, rep Row 4 until you have 196 sts.

Cut A.

SECOND SECTION, DECREASE HALF OF BLANKET

Next Row: With B, k2, k2tog, yo, knit to end of row – st count did not change on this row, you'll still have 196 sts.

Rep last row once more – 196 sts.

Decrease Row: With B, k2, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k to end of row – 195 sts.

With B, rep Decrease Row until you have 180 sts.

Drop B.

With C, rep Decrease Row twice.

Cut C.

With B, rep Decrease Row until you have 136 sts.

Cut B.

With C, rep Decrease Row twice.

Cut C.

With A, rep Decrease Row until you have 92 sts. Drop A.

With C, rep Decrease Row twice.

Cut C.

With A, rep Decrease Row until you have 72 sts. Cut A.

With C, rep Decrease Row twice.

Cut C.

With B, rep Decrease Row until you have 54 sts. Drop B.

With C, rep Decrease Row twice.

Cut C.

With B, rep Decrease Row until you have 6 sts.

Last Row: With B, k2, k2tog, yo, k2tog.

Bind off remaining 5 sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together
rep = repeat
st(s) = stitch(es)
