



Free Knitting Pattern

LION BRAND® FEELS LIKE BUTTA BONUS BUNDLE®

LILYBELLE FLOWER DRESS

Pattern Number: L90214



SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

6-9 months (9-12 months, 12-18 months)

Finished Chest About 18 1/2 (20, 21 1/2) in. (47 (51, 54.5) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Feels Like Butta Bonus Bundle® (Art. #123)
#103 Blossom 1 (1, 1) ball
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch holders
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

A few yards of white yarn to make the flower

GAUGE

18 sts = about 5 in. (12.5 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES

1. The Dress is worked in one piece beginning at lower edge, then divided at armholes.
2. A simple eyelet pattern is worked onto the skirt of the Dress.
3. The flower is worked separately then sewn to Dress.

Note:

The following corrections have been incorporated into the pattern below. We are highlighting the corrections separately here so that if you have printed out an earlier version of the pattern you'll know what was changed.

CORRECTIONS (applied Mar 03rd, 2023)

SHAPING

Row 1 (Decrease Row – RS): K2, *k11 (12, 13), k2tog; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 - you'll have 78 (84, 90) sts in this row.

Rows 2-4: Work in St st for 3 rows.

Row 5 (Decrease Row – RS): K2, *k10 (11, ~~13~~ 12), k2tog; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 – 72 (78, 84) sts.

DRESS

SKIRT

Cast on 84 (90, 96) sts.

Knit 6 rows for lower border.

Rows 1 and 2: Beg with a RS (knit) row, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) for 2 rows.

Row 3 (Eyelet Row – RS): K2, *yo, k2tog, k4; rep from * to last 4 sts, yo, k2tog, k2

Rows 4-6: Work in St st for 3 rows.

Row 7 (Eyelet Row – RS): K2, *k3, yo, k2tog, k1; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4.

Row 8: Purl.

Rows 9-16: Rep Rows 1-8.

Rows 17-22: Rep Rows 1-6.

Work in St st for 16 (20, 24) rows, ending with a WS row as the last row you work.

SHAPING

Row 1 (Decrease Row – RS): K2, *k11 (12, 13), k2tog; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 - you'll have 78 (84, 90) sts in this row.

Rows 2-4: Work in St st for 3 rows.

Row 5 (Decrease Row – RS): K2, *k10 (11, 12), k2tog; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 – 72 (78, 84) sts.

Rows 6-8: Work in St st for 3 rows.

Row 9 (Decrease Row – RS): K2, *k9 (10, 11), k2tog; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 – 66 (72, 78) sts.

Rows 10-12: Work in St st for 3 rows.

Rows 13-16: Knit 4 rows.

DIVIDE FOR FRONT AND BACK

FRONT

Row 1 (RS): Bind off 2 sts, k30 (33, 36) more sts; place rem 33 (36, 39) sts on a holder for back – 31 (34, 37) sts rem on needle.

Row 2: Bind off 2 sts, p to last 3 sts, k3 – 29 (32, 35) sts.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: K3, p to last 3 sts, k3.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 for 5 (6, 7) more times.

Knit 3 rows.

Bind off.

BACK

Return the 33 (36, 39) back sts from holder to needle so that you are ready to work a RS row.

Row 1 (RS): Bind off 2 sts, k to end of row – 31 (34, 37) sts.

Row 2 (WS): Bind off 2 sts, p to end of row – 29 (32, 35) sts.

Rows 3-6: Knit 4 rows.

Row 7 (Decrease Row – RS): K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 27 (30, 33) sts.

Rep Row 7 for 7 (8, 9) more times – 13 (14, 15) sts when all decreases have been completed.

STRAPS

Next Row: K5 and place on a holder for strap, bind off until 5 sts remain on your needle, k last 5 sts for strap.

FIRST STRAP

Work in Garter st (k every row) until strap measures about 5 (5, 5 1/4) in. (12.5 (12.5, 13.5) cm).

Bind off.

SECOND STRAP

Return the 5 strap sts from holder to needle.

Work same as first strap.

FINISHING

Sew bound-off end of each strap to top edge of corresponding corner of front.

FLOWER

With white yarn, cast on 40 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Purl 1 row.

Bind off.

Roll the flower into a spiral then, with white yarn threaded into blunt needle, take a few sts through the base of the roll to hold the shape.

Sew side edges of skirt together.

Sew Flower to front of Dress.

Weave in yarn ends.
