Lion Brand® Boogie Nights®
Monaco Shawl
Pattern Number: L90262



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZES

Finished Size About 30 x 60 in. (76 x 152.5 cm) at widest and longest

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Boogie Nights® (Art. #509)
 - #153 Ace of Spades 1 ball (A)
 - #142 Diamonds 1 ball (B)
 - #133 Birdcage 1 ball (C)
 - #123 Snake Eyes 1 ball (D)
 - #145 High Roller 2 balls (E)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

4 x 4 in. (10 x 10 cm) piece of cardboard

GAUGE

12 dc + 5 rows = about 4 1/4 in. (11 cm).
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Shawl is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows, beginning at center back neck.
2. The Shawl is worked with 5 colors of yarn and is shaped with increases.
3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Fasten off old color. Proceed with new color.
4. Tassels are made separately, then tied to Shawl.

SHAWL

With A, ch 4.

Row 1: With A, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc) – you will have 6 dc and 1 ch-2 sp in Row 1.

Row 2: With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first st, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in top of beg ch-3 – 12 dc, 2 ch-1 sps, and 1 ch-2 sp (6 dc and 1 ch-1 sp on each side of center ch-2 sp).

Row 3: With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first st, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in center ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in top of beg ch-3 – 18 dc, 4 ch-1 sps, and 1 ch-2 sp (9 dc and 2 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp).

Rows 4 and 5: With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first st., *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to center ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in center ch-2 sp, **ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from ** to last 3 sts, 3 dc in top of beg ch-3 – 15 dc (Five 3-dc groups) and 4 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp in Row 5.
Change to B.

Row 6: With B, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first st, hold beg ch-3 and first dc tog and work a dc around the posts of the pair, *ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp, hold the last 2 dc made tog and work a dc around the posts of the pair; rep from * to center ch-2 sp, ch 1, 2 dc in center ch-2 sp, hold the last 2 dc made tog and work a dc around the posts of the pair, ch 2, 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, hold the last 2 dc made tog and work a dc around the posts of the pair, **ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp, hold the last 2 dc made tog and work a dc around the posts of the pair; rep from ** to last 3 sts, ch 1, 2 dc in top of beg ch-3, hold the last 2 dc made tog and work a dc around the posts of the pair – 18 dc and 5 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp.
Change to C.

Rows 7-11: With C, rep Row 4 for 5 times – 33 dc and 10 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp in Row 11.
Change to B.

Row 12: With B, rep Row 6 – 36 dc and 11 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp.
Change to C.

Row 13: With C, rep Row 4 – 39 dc and 12 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp.
Change to B.

Row 14: With B, rep Row 6 – 42 dc and 13 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp.
Change to D.

Rows 15-19: With D, rep Row 4 for 5 times – 57 dc and 18 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp in Row 19.
Change to B.

Row 20: With B, rep Row 6 – 60 dc and 19 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp.
Change to D.

Rows 21-23: With D, rep Row 4 for 3 times – 69 dc and 22 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp in Row 23.
Change to B.

Row 24: With B, rep Row 6 – 72 dc and 23 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp.
Change to E.

Rows 25-31: With E, rep Row 4 for 7 times, changing color as in following sequence: Work 1 row with E, 1 row with A, 3 rows with E, 1 row with A, and 1 row with E – 93 dc and 30 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp in Row 31.
Change to B.

Row 32: With B, rep Row 6 – 96 dc and 31 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp. Change to E.

Rows 33-35: With E, rep Row 4 for 3 times – 105 dc and 34 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp in Row 35.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

TASSELS (MAKE 3)

Wrap A around cardboard – the more wraps, the fuller your tassel will be. Cut a 10 in. (25.5 cm) length of A and thread into blunt needle.

Draw needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard.

Cut a 6 in. (15 cm) length of A and wrap tightly around loops about 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) below top knot to form tassel neck. Knot securely; thread ends onto needle and weave ends to center of tassel.

Trim tassel ends evenly.

Tie a tassel to each corner of Shawl.
