Lion Brand® Soft Ball
Cluster Crochet Scarf
Pattern Number: L90229



SKILL LEVEL – Beginner

SIZES

About 6 x 64 in. (15 x 162.5 cm), not including fringe.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Soft Ball (Art. #141)
 - #146 Cosmos 1 ball (A)
 - #133 Gazelles 1 ball (B)
 - #102 Pink Sox 1 ball (C)
 - #103 Juiced 1 ball (D)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

11 sc = about 4 1/2 in. (11.5 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

Cl (2 double crochet cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), yarn over, insert hook in *same* st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (3 loops rem on hook), yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

sc-3rd (single crochet in 3rd loop) Insert hook in 3rd loop of indicated hdc and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook. **Note:** When working back and forth in rows, the 3rd loop of the hdc is on the side of the piece that is facing you, immediately below the front loop.

NOTES

1. Scarf is worked in one piece, lengthwise back and forth in rows, with 4 colors of yarn.
2. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

SCARF

With A, ch 156.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 155 sc in this row.

Row 2: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across and change to B in last st.

Row 3: With B, ch 1, turn, hdc in each st across and change to C in last st.

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Row 4: With C, ch 1, turn, sc-3rd in each st across and change to D in last st.

Row 5: With D, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * across and change to A in last st – 78 sc and 77 ch-1 sps.

Row 6: With A, ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, hdc in each st and ch across and change to C in last st – 155 sts.

Row 7: With C, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sk first 2 sts, Cl in next st, *ch 1, sk next st, Cl in next st; rep from * to last 2 sts, ch 1, sk next st, dc in last st and change to B – 2 dc, 76 Cl and 77 ch-1 sps.

Row 8: With B, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, Cl in first ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next Cl, Cl in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to last Cl, ch 1, sk last Cl, Cl in beg ch-4 sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 and change to D – 2 dc, 77 Cl and 76 ch-1 sps.

Row 9: With D, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sk first Cl, Cl in next ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next Cl, Cl in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to last Cl, ch 1, sk last Cl, dc in top of beg ch-3 and change to A – 2 dc, 76 Cl and 77 ch-1 sps.

Row 10: With A, ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, hdc in each st and ch to beg ch-4 sp, hdc in beg ch-4 sp, hdc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 and change to B – 155 sts.

Row 11: With B, rep Row 5 and change to C in last st.

Row 12: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in each sc and ch across and change to D in last st – 155 sc.

Row 13: With D, rep Row 3 and change to A in last st.

Row 14: With A, rep Row 4, do not change yarn color in last st.

Row 15: With A, ch 1 turn, sc in each st across.
Fasten off.

FINISHING **FRINGE**

Cut strands of yarn about 12 in. (30.5 cm) long. For each fringe, hold 3 strands of yarn together and fold in half.

Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of piece, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Make 11 fringes along each short end of Scarf, using yarn color to match stripes.

Trim fringe evenly to about 5 in. (12.5 cm) long.

Weave in ends.
