

# Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Windsor Cowl Pattern Number: L90328



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### SKILL LEVEL – Easy

## <u>SIZES</u>

**Finished Circumference** About 22 1/2 in. (57 cm) **Finished Height** About 10 in. (25.5 cm)

#### MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® (Art. #620)
  - #098 Natural Heather 1 skein (A)
  - #171 Gold 1 skein (B)
  - #180 Forest Green 1 skein (C)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 8 (5 mm), 24 in. (61 cm) long

#### **GAUGE**

17 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over stranded colorwork and St st worked in the rnd (k every st on every rnd)

#### STITCH EXPLANATION

**M1 (make 1)** An increase worked by lifting the horizontal strand lying between needles and placing it onto the left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop -1 st increased.

#### PATTERN STITCH

#### K2, p2 Rib (worked over a multiple of 4 sts)

**Rnd 1:** \*K2, p2; rep from \* around. Rep Rnd 1 for K2, p2 Rib.

## <u>NOTES</u>

- 1. Cowl is worked in one piece in the round.
- 2. Cowl begins and ends with ribbing. Between ribbed edges, stranded colorwork is worked, following a chart.
- 3. When working from chart, read every rnd from right to left and carry yarn not in use across inside of Cowl.

### COWL

With A, cast on 92 sts.

Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Work in K2, p2 Rib for 10 rnds. Purl 1 rnd. Next Rnd (Increase Rnd): (M1, k23) 4 times – 96 sts. Next 3 Rnds: Knit.

#### **Charted Colorwork**

Rnd 1: Knit, changing color following chart.

Beg with Rnd 2 of chart, continue to follow chart until a total of 35 rows of colorwork have been completed.

Continue with A only. Next 3 Rnds: Knit. Next Rnd (Decrease Rnd): (K2tog, k22) 4 times – 92 sts.

Purl 1 rnd. Work in K2, p2 Rib for 10 rnds. Bind off in rib.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

#### ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)
k = knit
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together
p = purl
rep = repeat
rnd(s) = round(s)
st(s) = stitch(es)
St st = Stockinette stitch
